Concept note and agenda

Background

The revised European Sports Charter (ESC) calls upon member states to ensure that everyone has the opportunity to take part in sport in a **safe**, **secure and healthy environment**. Projects such as the EU-CoE joint project Child Safeguarding in Sport (CSiS) or the Start to Talk initiative were designed and implemented to **enhance** the **safeguarding of children in sport**.

The Pool of International Experts on Safe Sport was set up to contribute to the work of the Council of Europe on safe sport issues. It builds on the previously established Pool of European Experts on Sexual Violence in Sport which has existed since 2017. The Pool of International Experts on Safe Sport is the single-entry point to a unique source of multi-disciplinary expertise covering all forms of violence and abuse against children in sport. Furthermore, this pool provides opportunities for peer-learning, capacity building and fostering exchanges among those who have a role to play in combating and preventing violence and abuse in sport.

Objectives of the meeting

The objectives of this meeting are:

- Get to know the work of the pool and the members:
 - o introduction of the mandate of the Pool of International Experts on Safe Sport;
 - benefits and responsibilities being a member of the pool;
 - o introduction of the members.
- Exchange of information on activities relating to safe sport:
 - o update on the activities of the Council of Europe in the field of safe sport;
 - o update on the activities of the members.
- Discuss possible priority areas of the pool of experts for the next two years.
