# EDUCATION

Education in Albania date back to the XVII century. The first school teaching Albanian language was established in Korça city, in 1887.



**Elementary and Secondary Education** 4698 pre-schools and school institutions

**Vocational Education** 40 vocational schools

**Higher Education** 11 public and 18 private universities

**Non-Public Education** Introduced for the first time in year 1992.  
Currently there exist 266 schools.

**Academy of Sciences** The Academy of Sciences of the Republic of Albania was established in 1972, joining 25 scientific research institutions that existed.

# Mission Statement and Organisational Structure

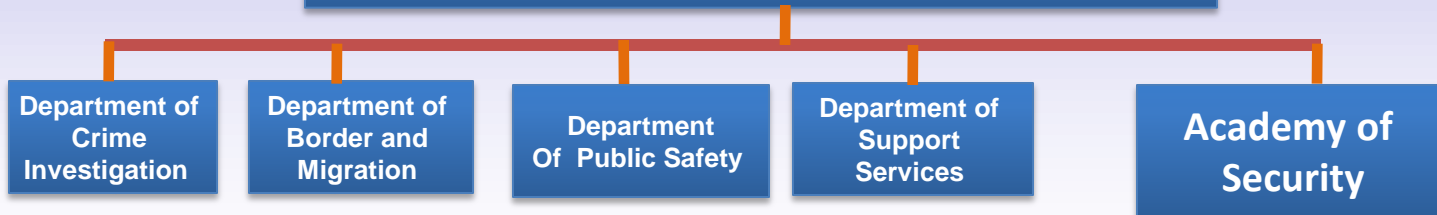
- Albania State Police is the police service of the Republic of Albania.

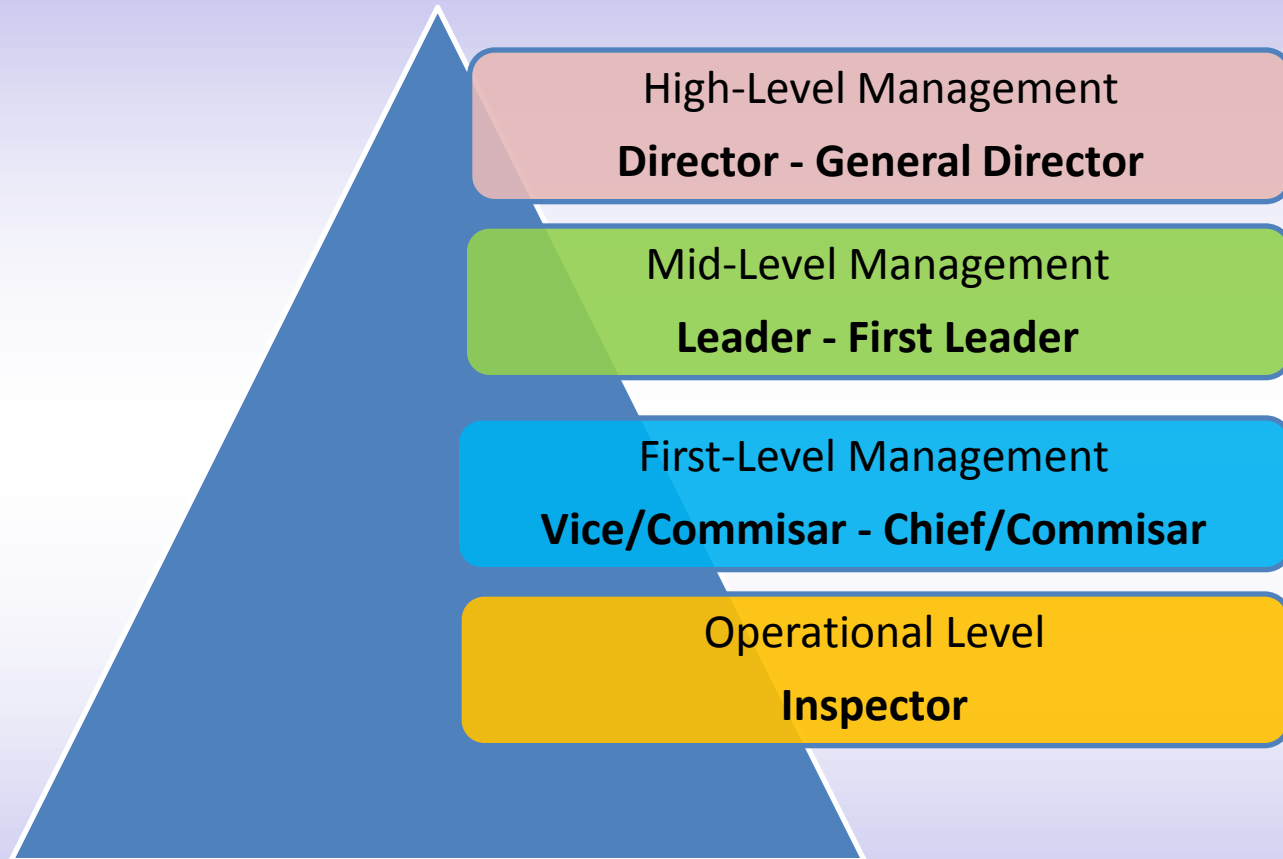

- On 25.02.2015 Albanian Academy of Security was established

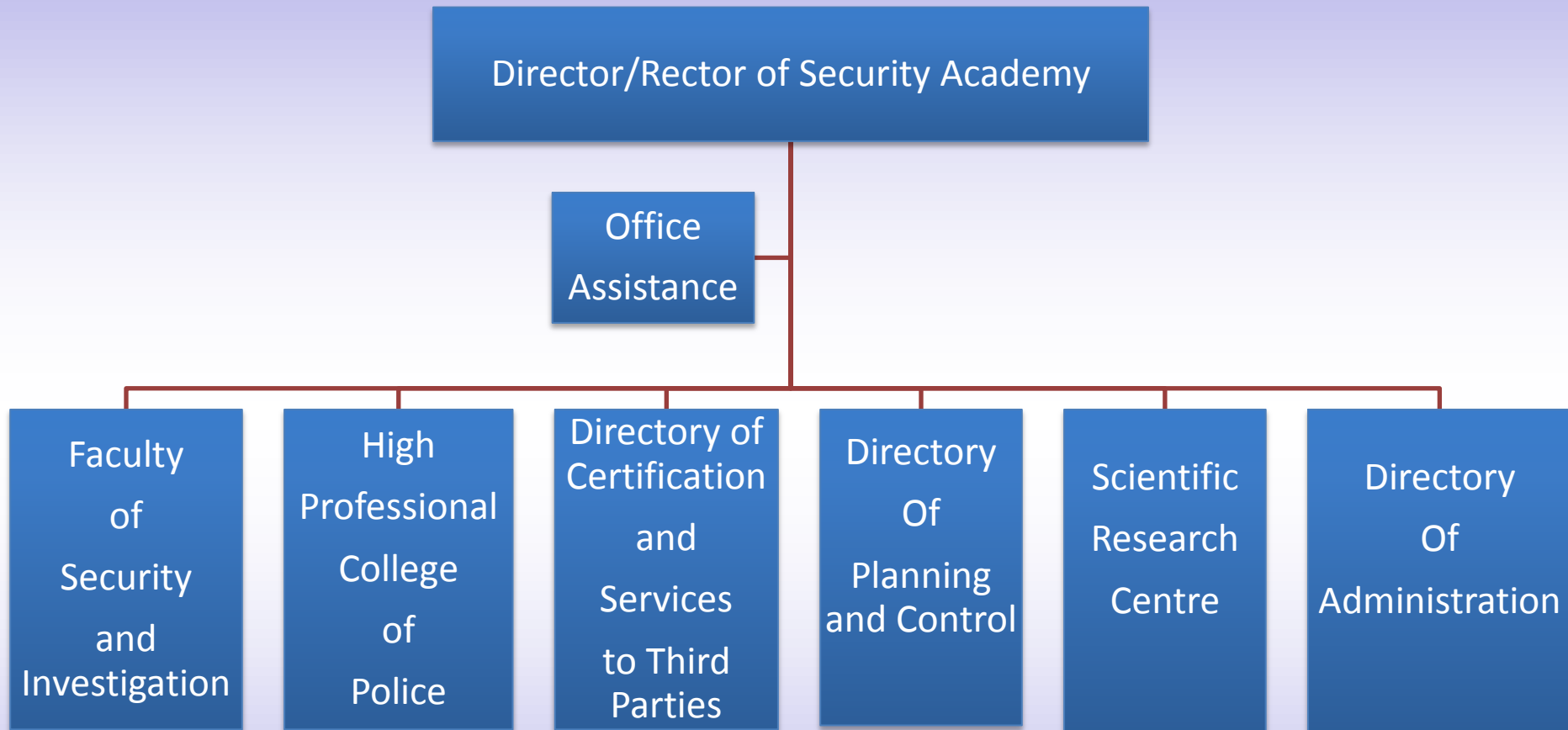




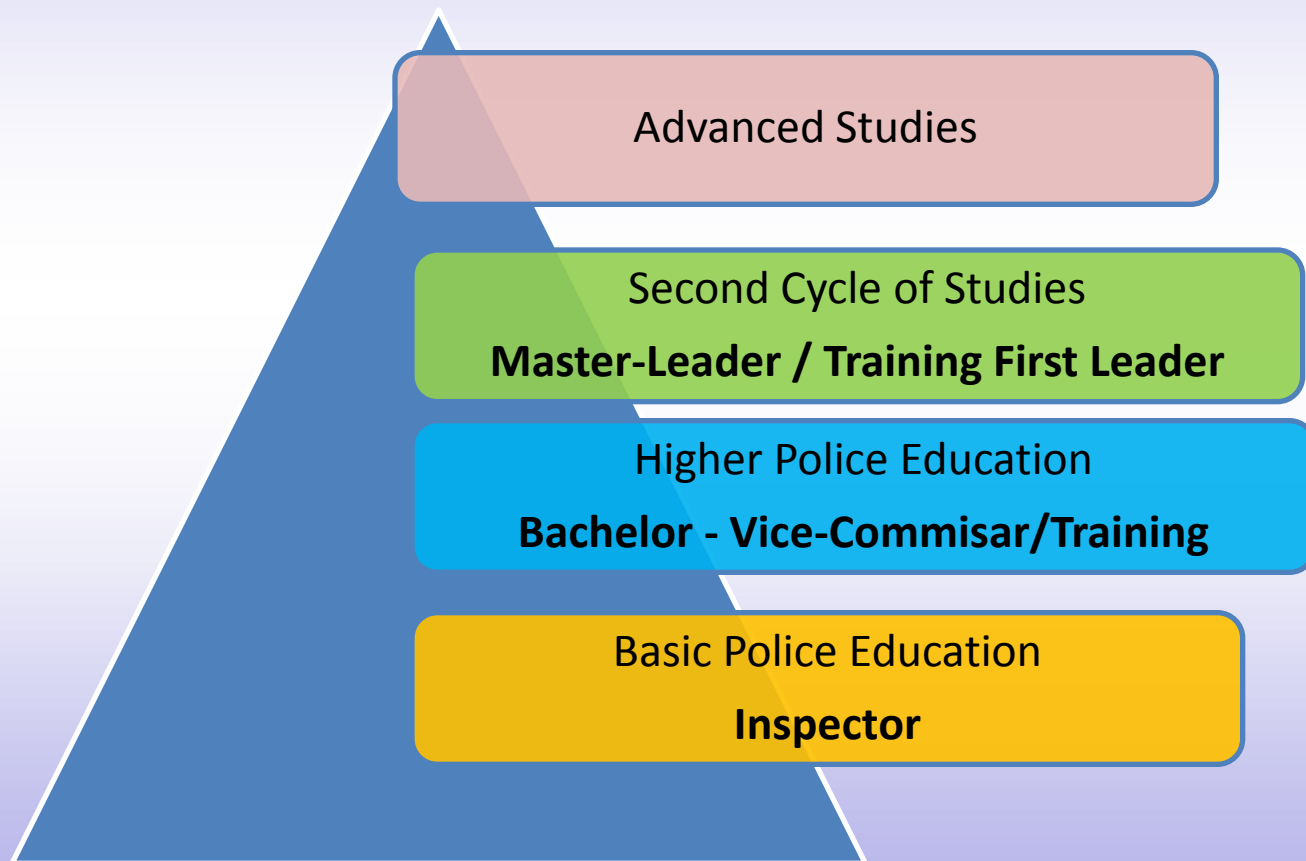
# THE MISSION OF THE ACADEMY OF SECURITY

- The Academy is a public institution which aims at educating the employees of the State Police and other law enforcement institutions.
- The main mission of the Academy is to develop and transmit knowledge through the process of teaching and scientific research.
- To develop relevant programs to improve the professional standards
- To provide basic police schooling for the trainers.
- To select and admit new shortlisted candidates as police officers according to the regulations
- To train and specialize senior officers to management position and offer them knowledge on strategic analyses and planning.
- To conduct all cycles university studies in the field of policing and security.

# THE STRUCTURE OF THE SECURITY ACADEMY

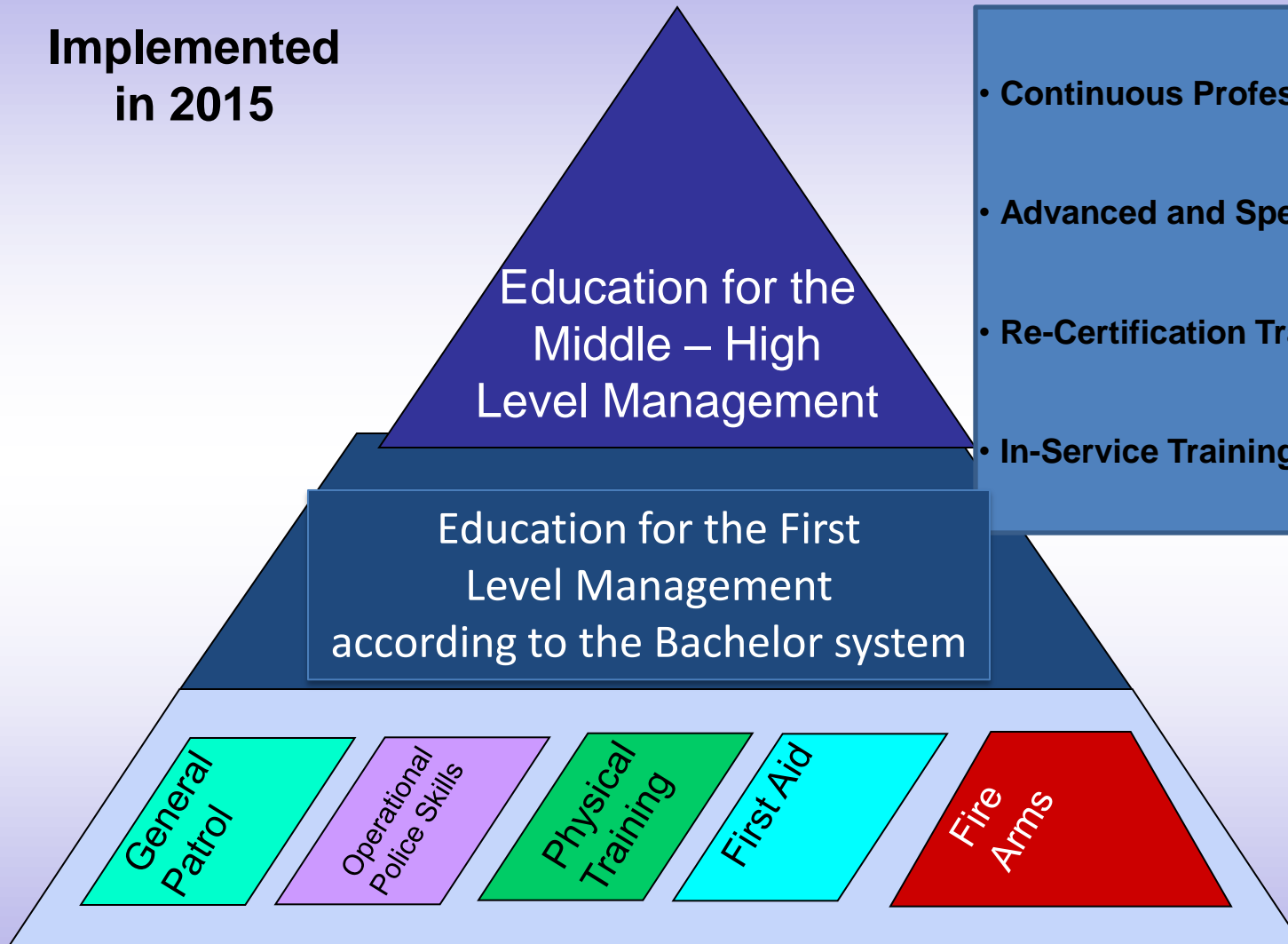


# The Pyramid of the Police Education System

# FORMS OF STUDY

**Academic study are conducted as follows:**

- Full time studies (Police College and Faculty of Public Security & Investigation).
- Career development qualifications (Doctor Professional and Science Master).
- Short- term trainings (Different trainings from 3-90 days).
- Special fields trainings (Different trainings from 3-30 days).

# TRAINING CAPACITIES

- Instructors /Trainers, 4 trainings for 100 trainers trained per year
- Standard Programs and Curricula, 300 candidates up to Inspector and 120 candidates up to Vice-Commissar
- Efficient and Standardized Training Facilities, 90 trainings with 270 participants
- Standard Operating Policies and Procedures
- Development Strategies

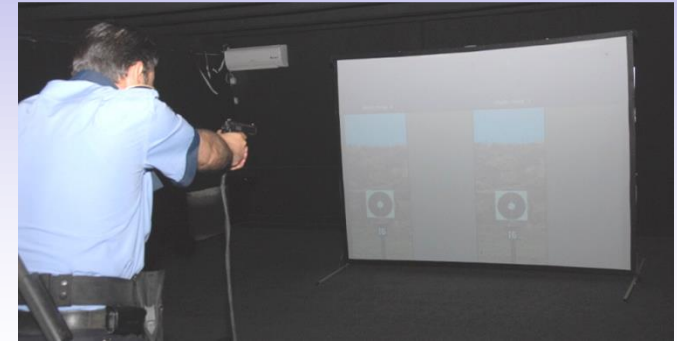

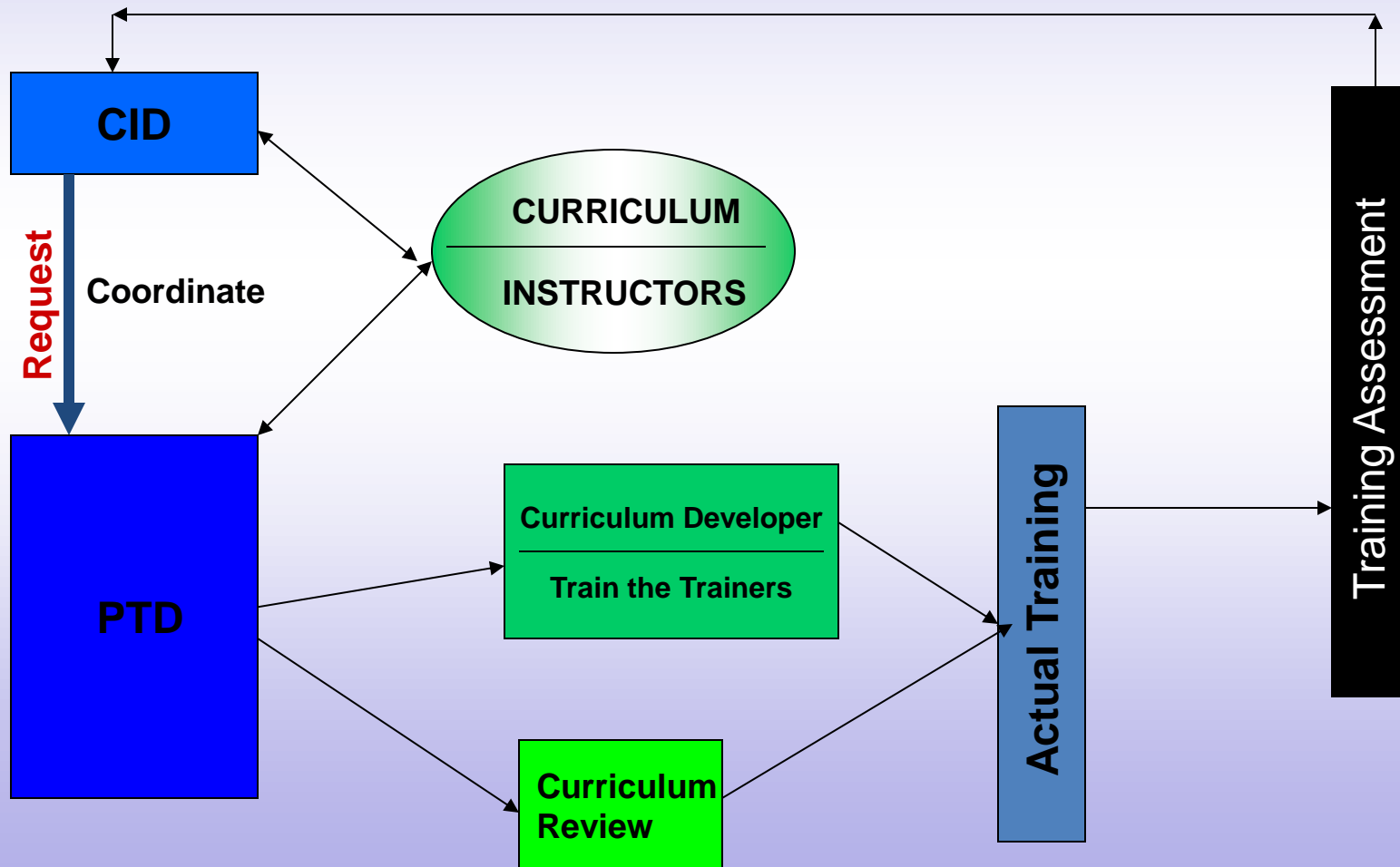
