- “Vertical” projects
 - Large projects (18-24 months) including 1-2 pilots
 - Ad-hoc “agile” projects (1-6 months), no pilot, smaller budget
- “Transversal projects”
 - Supporting several other projects on EU or national level
 - If needed can be recurrent (project redone every 2 years)
- Synergies
 - Links with between ECTEG projects
 - Links with non ECTEG projects

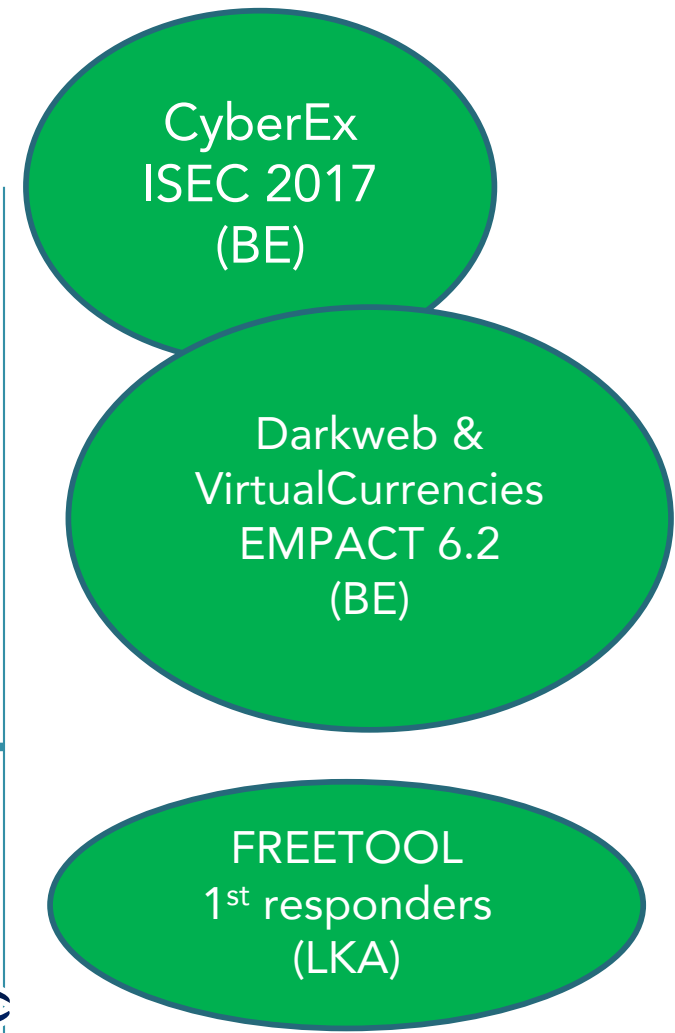
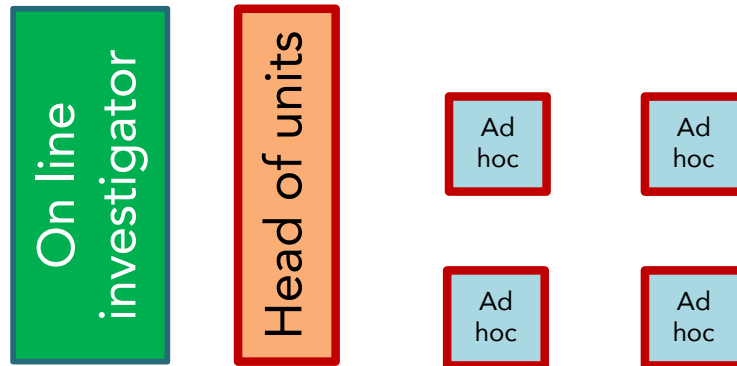


Support activity : administration

Project : Online investigators

- Driven by UCD (Ireland) based on a previous project slightly adapted
- Covers the TCF profile
- Deliverables :
 - 3 weeks training package with on-line resources
- Pilot : 2018 : 3 x 1 week with exercises in between
- Synergy with :
 - Existing initiatives in EC3 on good practices and tools
 - Certification deployment project



Project : E-learning first responders

- Deliverables :
 - 7 EU languages e-learning packages (incl. Spanish & Portuguese)
 - Reference network of contributors around EU
 - Updating tools (opt-in and pull)
- Synergies :
 - Transversal support for all other modules as “introductory” module
 - Support for LKA Wiesbaden FREETOOL 1st responders residential IW training
 - Support to EEAS aims to improve IT crime capacity building in Latin America
- Part of IT concepts (final draft) being available for the FREETOOL – 1st responders pilot training in October 2017
