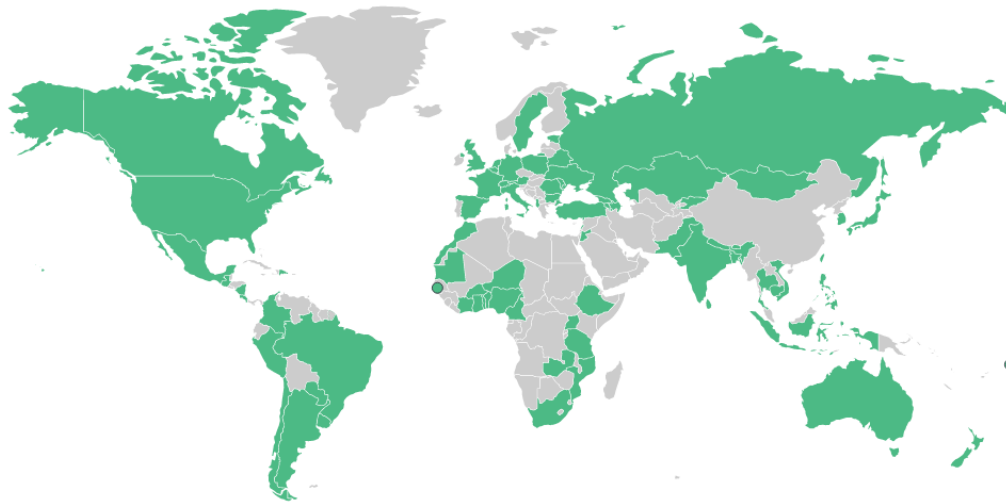

# 1: CAPACITY BUILDING

- **Training of judges and prosecutors** on OCSE in Africa
- The overall objective- equip them with specialist knowledge on OCSE so as to improve the access to justice for OCSE victims.
- Targeting 19 countries
- When- 2019

## 2: RESEARCH

- **Generate knowledge on CSAM in peer-to-peer networks (P2P)**
- P2P file sharing services remain the most common method for distribution of CSAM
- Objective - determine the pattern of access (download and upload) of CSAM in at least 18 African countries.

### 3: ADVOCATING FOR NATIONAL RESPONSES AGAINST OCSE



- Create awareness among policy makers
- Advocate for African governments to implement the Model National Response (MNR)
- MNR guides countries in evaluating their current response, identifying gaps & prioritizing efforts

## 4: ADVOCACY TOWARDS INTERNET INDUSTRY

- Engage ICT companies to use tools in their systems to detect and block known child abuse images e.g. PhotoDNA.

## • 5. PROMOTION OF HOTLINES/ REPORTING PORTALS ON CSAM

- ECPAT is working with IWF in the establishment of reporting portals in African countries.
