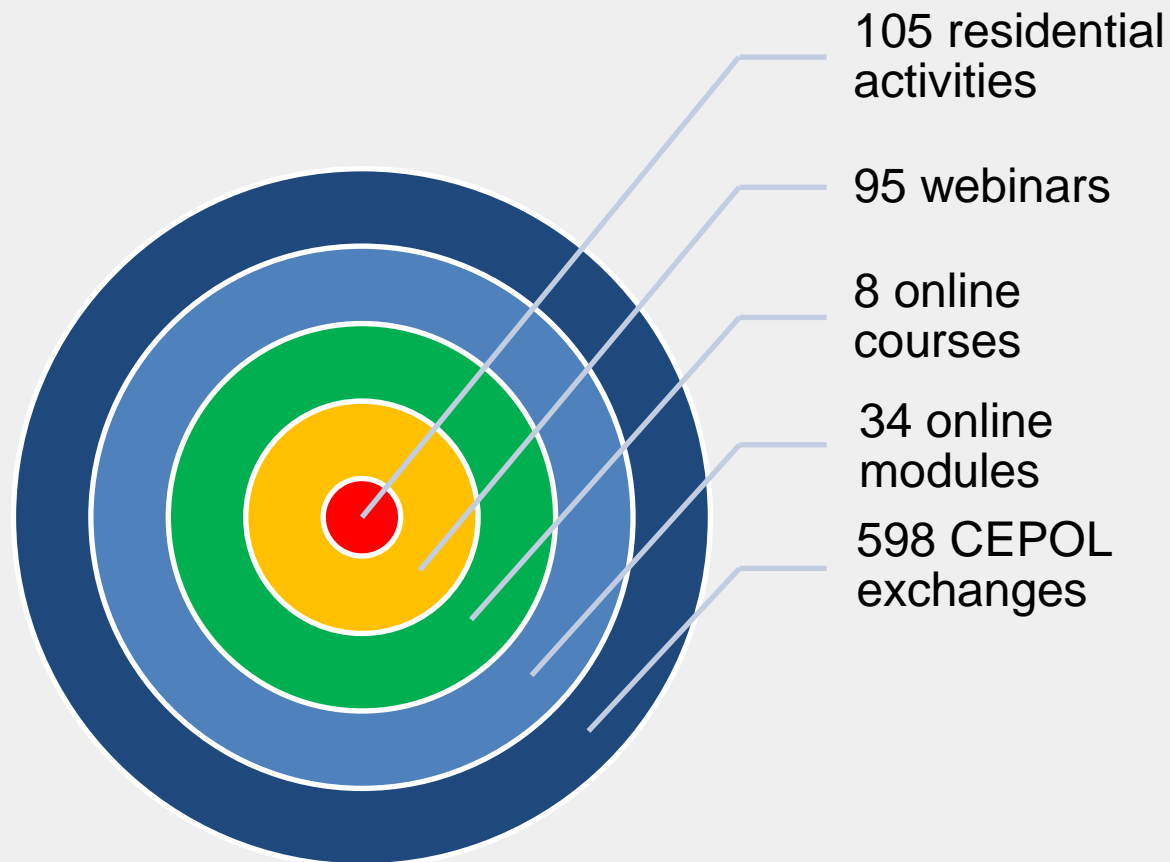
What is CEPOL?

- contributes to a safer Europe by facilitating cooperation and knowledge sharing among law enforcement officials

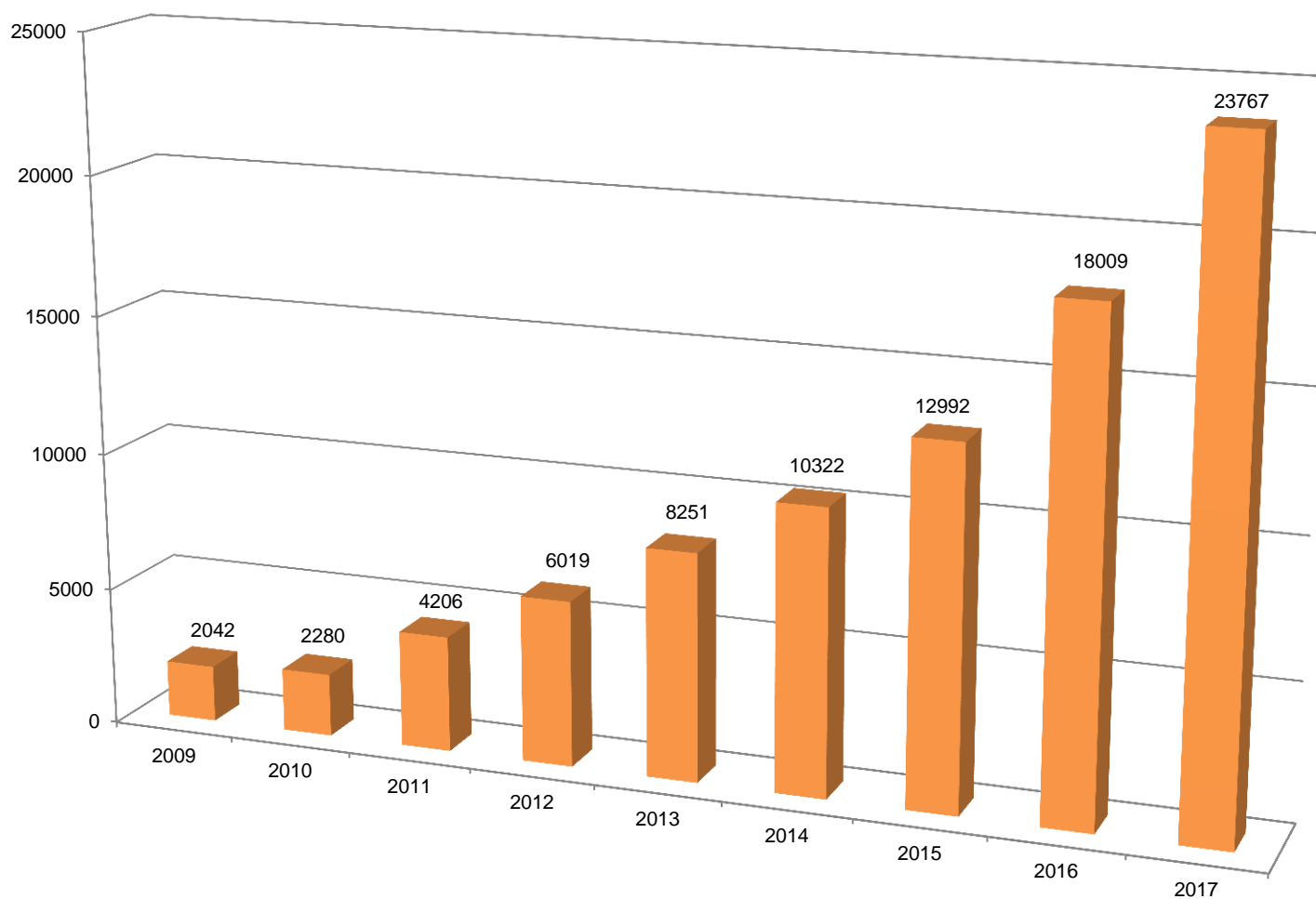

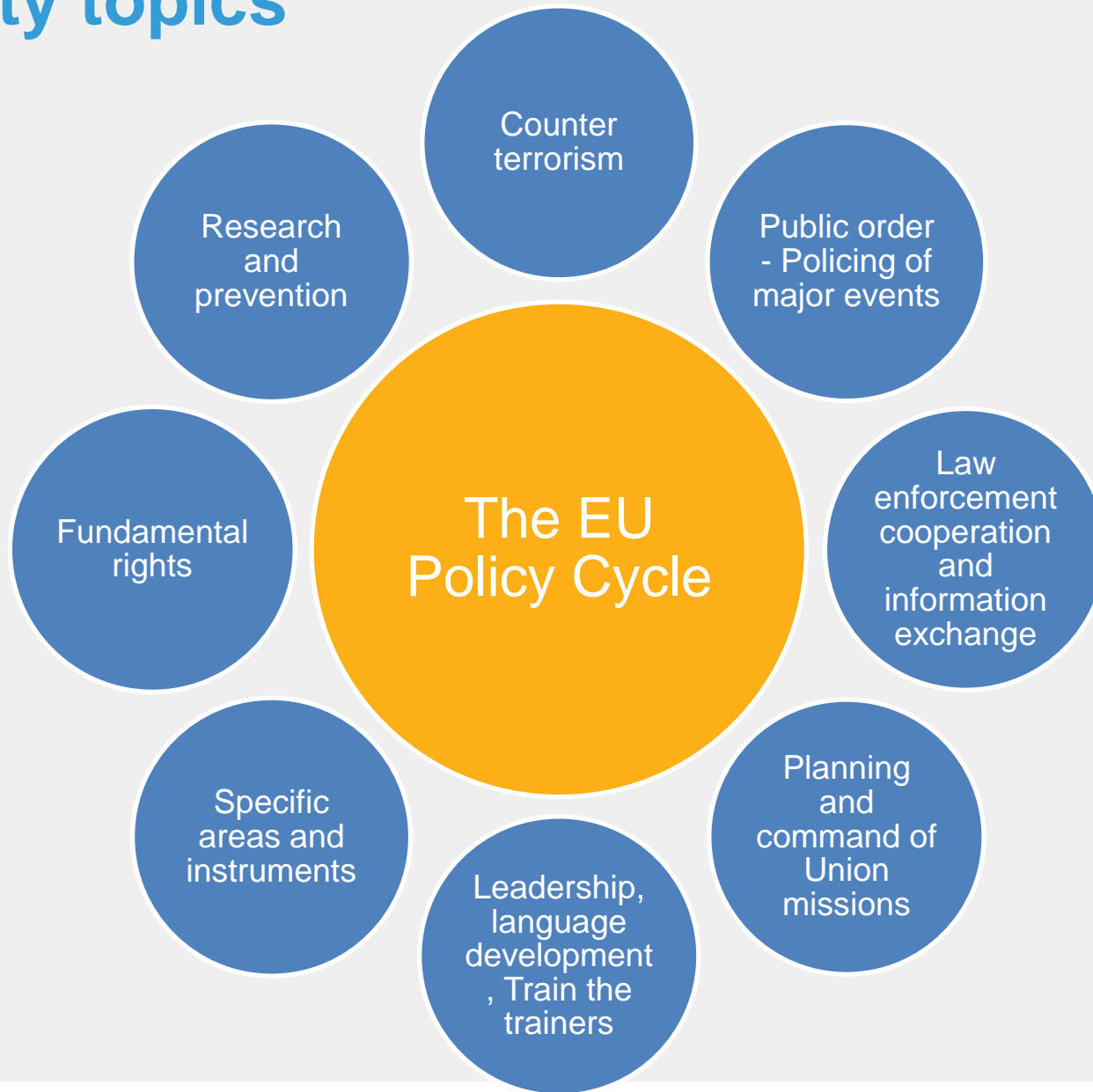


Evolution of participation in CEPOL activities

Number of participants

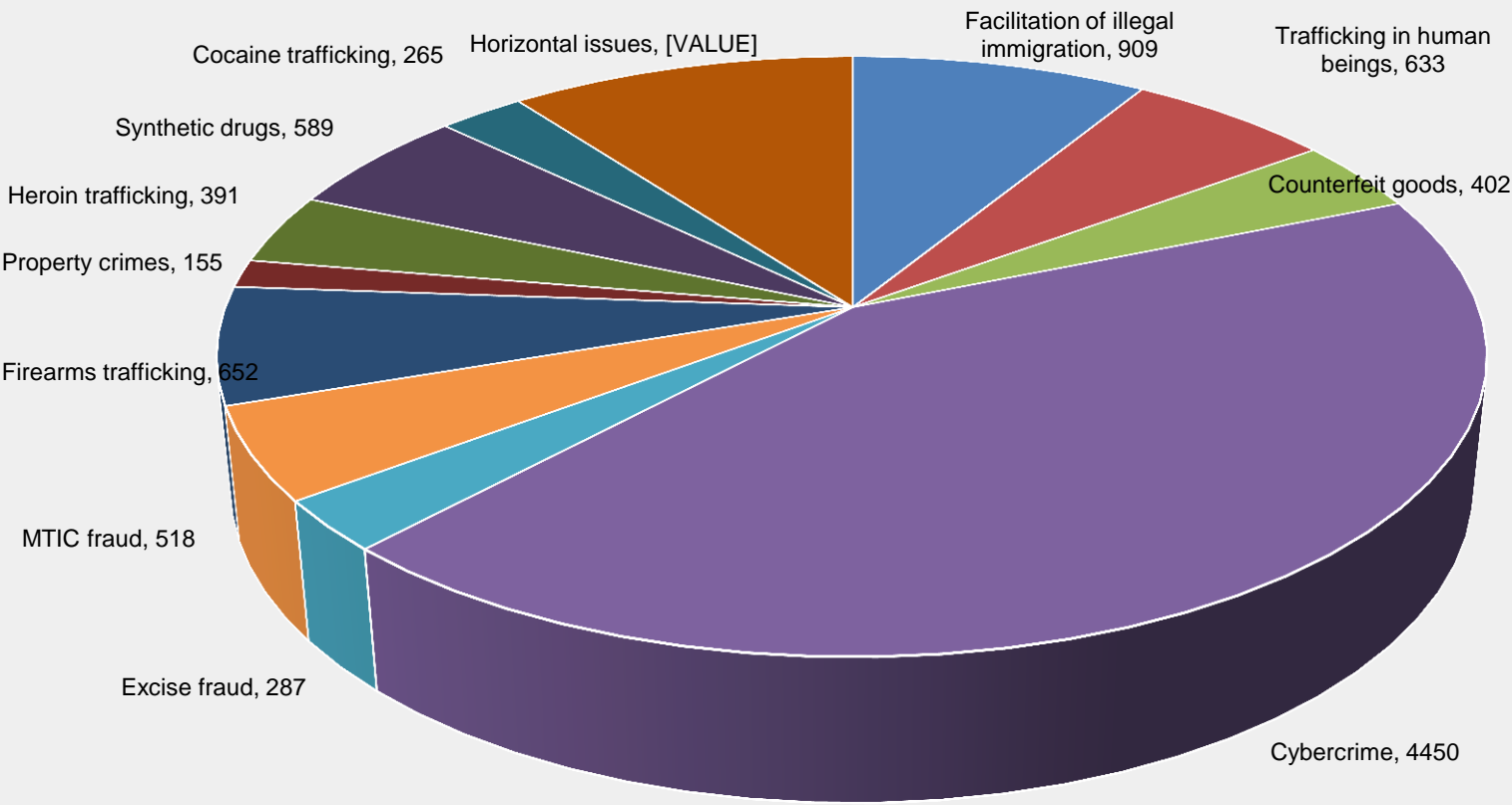


2017 priority topics



Courses on the EU Policy Cycle

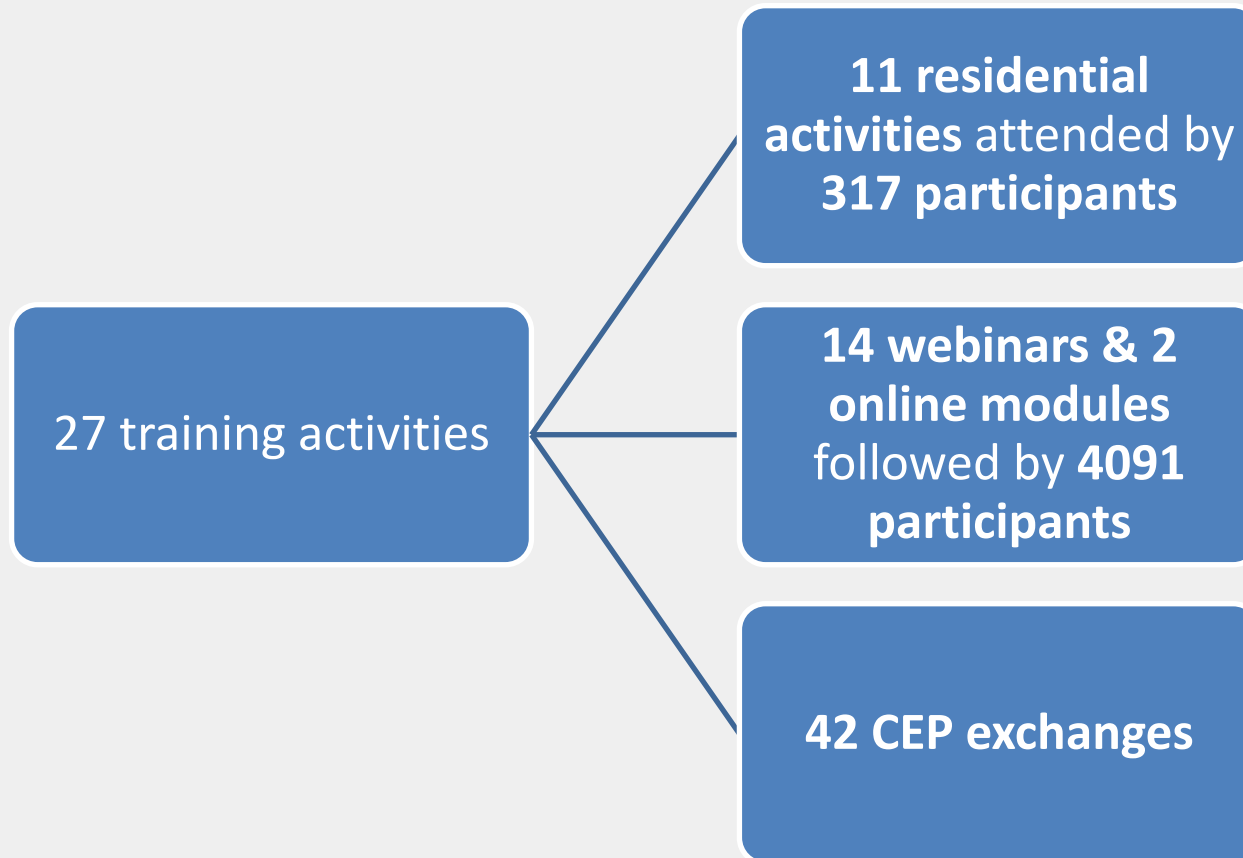
Number of trained officials per EU Policy Cycle priority

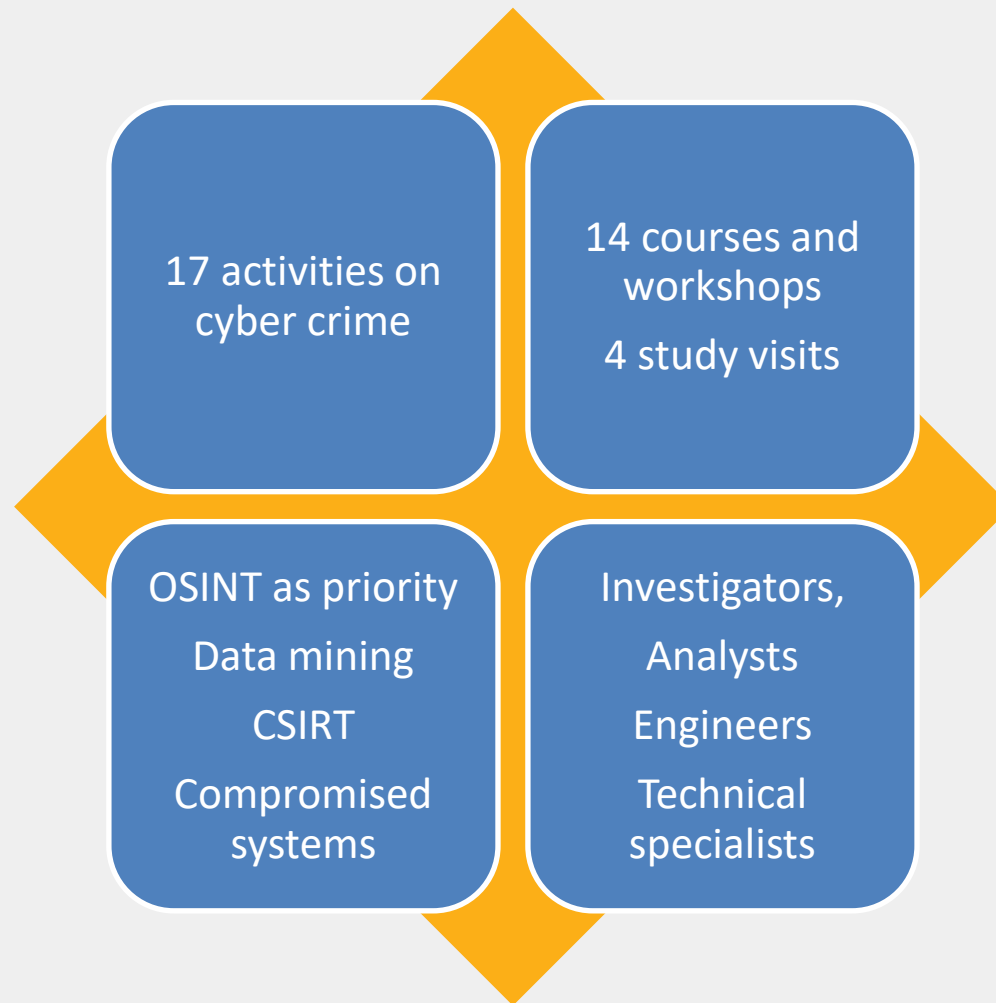
