#### **7. Visit to the “Equality Space” – hosted by the city of Strasbourg**

The Equality Space hosts a unique interactive educational path specifically targeting children who are often confronted with real situations of discrimination. The aim is to help them develop their critical thinking towards situations that may generate discrimination. The space was developed thanks to the

reflections of the city officials involved in the fight against discrimination following the 2015 terrorist attacks in Paris. It became a permanent project in 2019 and is now developed in cooperation with a number of grassroots organisations such as: ASTU (Action Citoyennes interculturelles), Centre socio-culturel Victor Schœlcher, Espaces dialogues, Francas du Bas-Rhin, La Maison des potes, Ligue de l'enseignement FOL 67, Lire et faire lire, Nadi Chaabi, Mouvement français du Planning familial (French family planning movement), MRAP, SOS Aide aux habitants, THEMIS, le Furet, la Station LGBTI, Familangues. The project is coordinated by the anti-discrimination department of the City of Strasbourg, in partnership with various other departments including the Department of Childhood and Education, and with the support of the Department of Education's Academic Services and the City Policy.
