Linking Lynx Activities 2023-25*:

1. Develop a Conservation Strategy for the lynx in the Carpathian Mountains.

- Cooperation Bern Convention, Carpathian Convention, IUCN, and all Range Countries

2. Develop IUCN Guidelines for the Recovery of the Carpathian lynx populations in West and Central Europe

- Provide guidance for reintroductions/reinforcement to European countries and decision makers

3. Develop Protocols to harmonise and synchronise lynx conservation in West and Central Europe

- Synchronise offer/demand of lynx for reintroduction and reinforcement, harmonise
