## Inter-Agency Council Against Child Pornography (IACACP)

- Created in 2010 by virtue of Republic Act 9775 or Anti Child Pornography Act of 2009
- Established as the body that is primarily tasked to **COORDINATE, MONITOR,** and **OVERSEE** the implementation of the Act
- Composed of 12 line agency members and 3 non-government organizations
- Chaired by Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) and Vice-chaired by Department of Justice (DOJ)

# **National Response Plan (NRP) on Online Sexual Abuse and Exploitation of Children**

- Using the “we protect framework”, IACACP arrived with Five (5) Key Result Areas as roadmap from 2015-2017 in the accomplishment of the goals of the Council.
- Members of the ICACP are divided into the areas or committees according to their field of expertise.

# Initiatives of IACACP in relation to the NRP

## I. Advocacy and Prevention

- Production and distribution of Information, Education, and Communication Materials (IEC)/ advocacy posters
- Multi-Sectoral Advocacy: Development of *Praymer* (Primer) on RA 9775/ Anti-child pornography act of 2009 for Local Government Units
- Web and App-based Advocacy: #StopChildPornPHProject and Hackathon 2016
- Proclamation of Safer Internet Day (**2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday of February every Year**)
- Conduct of forums, orientations, and trainings to various sectors

## II. Law Enforcement and Prosecution

- Department of Justice's Office of the Cybercrime (DOJ-OOC) as the Philippines' point-of-contact received **66,000** (more or less) reports of OSEC from the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children (NCMEC) from 2014-2016.
- For 2017, a total of **26,000** reports coming from NCMEC was received by the DOJ-OOC (Jan to Mar)
- Training on investigation of computer-facilitated crimes against children by Philippine National Police



### **III. Protection, Recovery and Reintegration**

- For 2016, DSWD catered to 24 victims (community-based) and 61 victims (residential services) of child pornography in all Field Offices.
- Development and roll-out of Multi-Disciplinary Training in handling and managing OSEC
- Reporting of child pornographic sites through messaging and trafficking hotline

- Conduct of Child Online Protection Summit, National Consultation on Child Online Protection, Compendium of Good Practices on Efforts to Address OSEC in the Philippines, among others.
- Initiatives in amending RA 9775
