The project "Back to the Roots" is a conceptual set of targeted development activities aimed at enhancing the cultural and historical potential of the municipality of Bojná, linked to an important power and economic centre and one of the best-preserved Slavic fortification sites of Great Moravia in the municipality of Bojná, where unique archaeological findings from the 9th century AD have been discovered, documenting the life of the ancestors of the Slovaks and the beginnings of Christianity in Slovakia.

The outputs of the project include the construction of a permanent exhibition in the open air with model reconstructions of objects in the territory of the archaeological site of the Valy hill-fort and its sensitive restoration, the establishment of a museum exhibition in the municipality, the application of innovative forms of education and the purposeful increase of public awareness of the value of the land through experiential learning of the national cultural heritage.

The main partner of the project is the Institute of Archaeology of the Slovak Academy of Sciences in Nitra, which provided professional background during the development of the entire project.
