Reintroduction of the Gaitered Gazelle in Vashlovani Landscape, Georgia

- The Gazelle once inhabited the whole of the semi-arid zone of Georgia as part of a contiguous population across the South Caucasus and beyond.
- Due to agricultural expansion and intense hunting, the species became extinct in Georgia in the 1990s
- After the successful implementation of the project estimated number of Gazelles in Georgia is more than 250 individuals.
