*The travelling exhibition prepared in the project **Protection and development of the Slovenian landscape: Starting points for landscape policy** is aimed at presenting the constant change of the landscape and the need for a comprehensive management of these changes, brought about by the proposed Landscape policy of Slovenia. The exhibition continues to travel through Slovenia to further raise awareness of the importance of the landscape and its comprehensive management.*



*The exhibition shows pairs of photographs of the same landscapes taken more than three decades apart. The historic photos were taken by the landscape architect professor Dušan Ogrin. Each pair is accompanied by a commentary by an expert who works in the displayed landscape. The comparison of two time sections is accompanied by a collage of images of modern, everyday landscapes, showing current trends in changing the landscape (right strip) and highlighting the question of the future of the Slovenian landscape, its quality and the way it is managed.*



*The exhibition is also a tribute to the founders of Slovenian landscape architecture, professor emeritus Dušan Ogrin (1929-2019) and professor emeritus Janez Marušič (1939).*
