A Millennial Tradition of Self - Government and sustainable forest management

WOODS

13,000 hectares, located 1500 m above sea level, managed through 10 forest management plans

The forestry technical office of the entity, established in 1877, ensures that over the years the forest heritage is not undermined and guarantees its protection and continuous renewal and growth.

GARDEN CENTRES

Currently the annual production is 50,000 seedlings; 2,000 are needed to cover one hectare of forest

The Magnificent Community of Fiemme owns two vineyards - one active and the other in the process of restoration and enhancement- where small firs, larches and cymbal pines are sown and grown, which are subsequently planted in the forest, helping natural renewal in areas with the highest hydrogeological risk or where regrowth is slower.

New challenges

The Vaia storm of 2018 and the consequent bark beetle epidemic have imposed a great commitment to research, innovation and coordination to face the disaster of 3000 hectares of destroyed forest, ecosystem risks and very serious economic losses.

The Sawmill

Part of the timber from the certified forests of the Magnificent Community is processed in the sawmill of Ziano di Fiemme, 40% powered by photovoltaic panels

In the sawmill of the Magnificent Community of Fiemme, the wood is processed by modern machinery and transformed into quality products (wide range of boards and semi-finished products) sold in Italy and Europe. All products can be supplied with FSC® and PEFC Chain of Custody certifications.

Social role

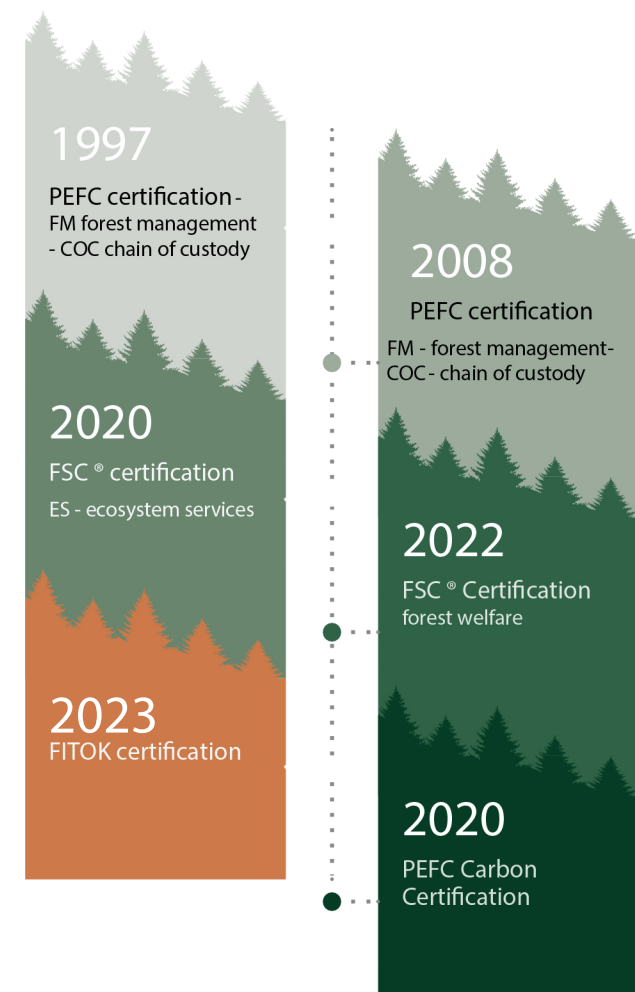
The Neighbours enjoy the rights of civic use (for example, the right to timber, fishing, collection of undergrowth products, pasture and grassland).

Part of the income from property management is used to support the most needy social groups and designed to the social, cultural and economic progress of the entire Neighbourhood Community.

Not only timber

There are several ecosystem services that the forest makes available to the community: conservation of biodiversity, carbon removal and storage, water regulation services, conservation of resources and recreational services.

With the FSC® and PEFC certifications, the Magnificent Fiemme Community is carrying out important work to enhance ecosystem services, also through specific projects aimed at generating sustainability credits.



The Magnificent Community of Fiemme is a unique institution in Italy, among the oldest surviving testimonies of self-governing: from almost 1,000 years responsibly and sustainably manages the assets of the Neighbours in a territory that extends over 11 Rules, and which today amounts to more than 20,000 hectares.
