



European Convention on the Transfer of Proceedings in Criminal Matters

Strasbourg, 15.V.1972

Appendix II * (Article 41)

Any Contracting State may declare that for reasons arising out of its constitutional law it can make or receive requests for proceedings only in circumstances specified in its municipal law.

Any Contracting State may, by means of a declaration, define as far as it is concerned the term "national" within the meaning of this Convention:

Albania

Albanian nationals as well as stateless persons permanently residing in Albania and persons with double nationality, in case either of them is Albanian.

Armenia

A person who is a national of the Republic of Armenia, as well as a person who has a status of refugee of the Republic of Armenia.

Cyprus

A citizen of the Republic of Cyprus or a person who would be entitled, under the laws relating to citizenship in force for the time being, to become citizen of the Republic.

Lithuania

A person who is a citizen of the Republic of Lithuania in accordance with its laws.

Republic of Moldova

A citizen of the Republic of Moldova, the foreign citizen or stateless person with residence permits in the Republic of Moldova.

Romania

For the purpose of this Convention, the term "national" shall mean "citizen".
