- ➤ Ukraine: complementarity to joint CoE-EU projects of 2012 and 2014-2015
- ➤ Georgia: 2013 and 2014, legal expertise on the issue of framing the surveillance activities of the law enforcement agencies



Programmatic Co-operation Framework (PCF) Planned activities

- Legal analysis to assess the data protection legislation, in light of the relevant international and European standards.
- ➤ An expert seminar on the legal system to discuss the findings of the experts and to agree on proposals for amendments.
