WHY THIS CAMPAIGN?

Hate speech on the Internet has become a major form of online human rights abuse, with serious, sometimes tragic, consequences, both online and offline.

The Internet needs to be reclaimed as a safe, global space for creativity, communication and participation, by and for everyone.

WHAT IS THE NO HATE SPEECH MOVEMENT?

The No Hate Speech Movement is a Council of Europe youth campaign to address and combat hate speech by mobilising young people to speak up for human rights and democracy online, and to reduce acceptance of hate speech by reporting and denouncing it. There are national campaigns in over 40 countries, working together with European partners and activists.

- The campaign promotes human rights education through the manual Bookmarks.
- There are common action days to raise awareness of specific forms of online hate speech.
