


The Roma, estimated at between 10 and 15 million people, including Turkey, constitute the largest minority in Europe and are present practically in all Council of Europe member states.

The size of the Roma community between 1 – 6 million



The size of the Roma community Less than 1 million



Roma are a greatly diverse group of individuals and communities, united by a common origin, a common language (Romanes) and a long history of persecution.

The status of the Roma in the CoE Member states is different from state to state, but at the same time seems that discrimination and exclusion are common features for Roma regardless of the state they are in.

The Framework Convention for the Protection of National Minorities has the quality of being the first legally binding multilateral instrument that focuses on the protection of the rights of the minorities' members.




Little known within the Roma community

## NATURE OF THE CONVENTION

- Convention perceived as a loos set of principles;
- No definition of "national minorities" – Subject of the FCPNM are citizens;
- Enforcement mechanism TOO WEAK;
- Lack of complaints procedures.
- Anti-Gypsyism

# PERCEPTION ROMA HAVE ABOUT THEIR RIGHTS

- Roma do not necessarily see themselves as national minority;
- Recognition of an ethnic minorities can be restrictive of rights.

### **PROPOSALS**

ERTF organize jointly with the Secretariat of the Framework Convention a seminar for international Roma and non-Roma;

Public education campaigns, involving the media and other communication outlets, can also be undertaken to increase general awareness of the Convention and related instruments;

The ERTF should undertake to make the Roma national organisations aware of the Convention and explain to them ways and means of exploiting it;

### **PROPOSALS**

Translation of the recommendations to the language understandable to the minorities members;

Request the Advisory Committee to come back once again the the ERTF proposal for establishing a Charter for the Rights of the Roma as an inter- complementary system;

Explore the possibilities for establishing a complaint mechanism.
