The Council of Europe's **education programme** stems from the European Cultural Convention (ETS n° 18) and the Convention on the Recognition of Qualifications concerning Higher Education in the European Region (ETS n° 165) as well as from several Recommendations adopted by the Committee of Ministers in relation to the public responsibility for effective implementation of quality inclusive education as well as democratic citizenship, human rights and antidiscrimination in education.

— In the field of education, the CoE stresses the importance of quality education and the development of a culture of democracy, throughout all levels of education.

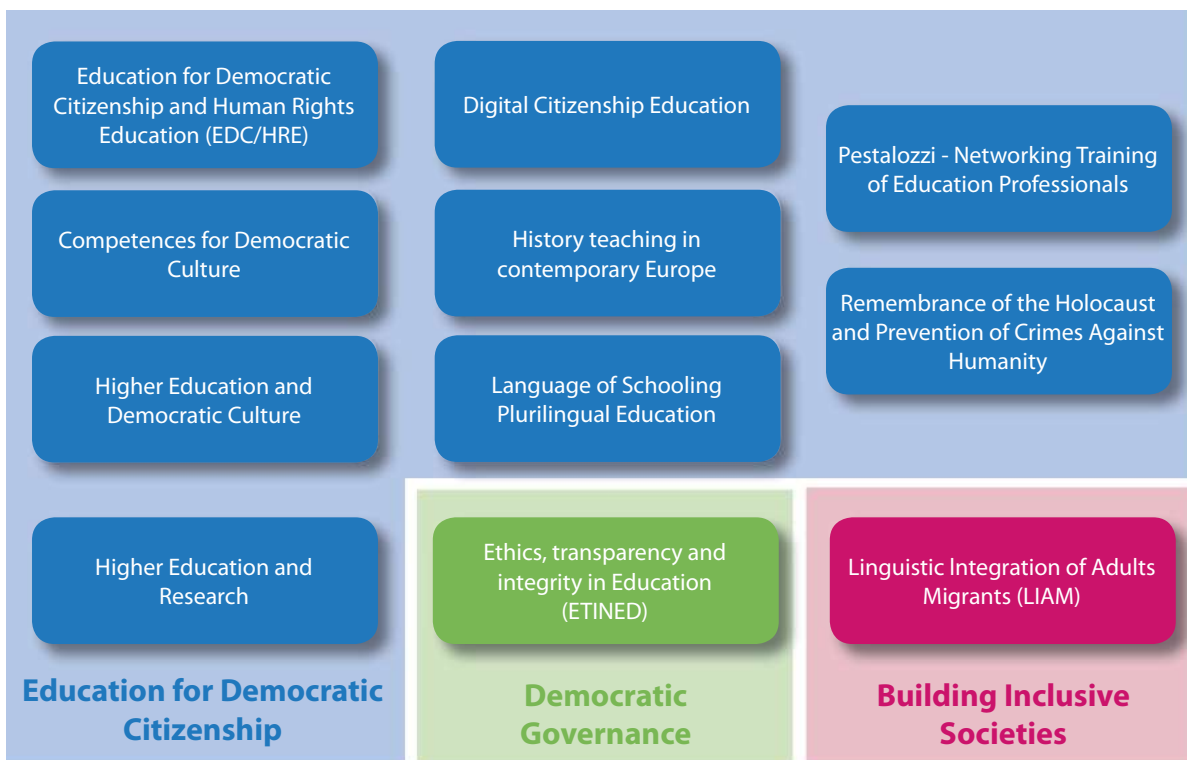
