1. PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION: 1 – 30 JUNE 2008

1.1 Project activities

Start-up Conference and Steering Committee Meeting

The Project's Start-up Conference and the first meeting of the Steering Committee took place on 25 and 26 June in Rome, Italy. The Ministry of Justice of Italy has undertaken the logistical part of organisation of this event.

The objective of the Start-up Conference was to present the project to the organisations and institutions involved in its implementation and to share updated information between the contact persons of each project area about the latest developments in the field of judicial co-operation. Representatives of the Italian Ministry of Justice, Anti-Mafia Bureau of Italy, European Commission, Council of Europe, Ministries of Justice and Prosecutor's Offices from Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, Montenegro, Serbia and "the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia" and Regional Co-operation Council were present at the Conference. Kosovo was the only project area which did not have its representatives present at this conference. The objective of the Steering Committee Meeting was to agree upon a workplan and calendar of the activities for 2008.

1.2 Other activities

Meetings in Project Areas

On 9 June the Project Manager visited Tirana, Albania, and met with the representatives from the Ministry of Justice, Mrs Marsida Xhafellari, and Prosecutor's Office, Mr Arben Kraja, who were appointed the Project's Contact Persons for Albania. The objective of the meeting was to present the project and its objectives, to discuss the activities to be held in Albania, to announce the Start-up conference and Meeting of the Steering Committee which were to take place on 25 and 26 June in Rome. Representatives from the Council of Europe and the EC Delegation in Albania took part in the meetings.
