First meeting took place in Warsaw in 2001 when the representatives of the personal data protection authorities from Czech Republic, Hungary, Lithuania, the Republic of Estonia, the Republic of Latvia, Poland and Slovakia declared the will of co-operation and mutual help in the scope necessary to ensure proper personal data protection in their countries.
