# COUNCIL OF EUROPE AND EUROPEAN COMMISSION CARDS REGIONAL POLICE PROJECT

Welcome to the January edition of our Newsletter. A number of activities were carried out from 25 October when we issued our last Newsletter, within the CARDS Police Regional Project: "Development of Reliable and Functioning Policing Systems and Enhancing of Combating Main Criminal Activities and Police Co-operation" (CARPO).

The CARPO project, which started in March 2004, aims at strengthening the capacities of Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, Serbia and Montenegro and "the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia" to develop and implement regional strategies against serious forms of crime based on the *acquis* of the

European Union and other European standards and practices by:

- providing them with the necessary tools against economic and organised crime (module 1, co-ordinated by the Council of Europe)
- enabling them to deliver comprehensive training against trafficking in human beings, smuggling and illegal migration (module 2, co-ordinated by the International Organization for Migration).
