Place, date and time

The seminar will be held at the UNMIK HQ, SRSG's Building, Main Conference Room, 6th floor, from 2 to 3 September 2004, beginning at 9h30.

Registration

The registration of participants will take place between 9h10 and 9h25. Participants are invited to present themselves at the main entrance of the UNMIK HQ with their invitation letter and passport on the day of a meeting, at least 20 minutes before the opening of the meeting, in order to receive their badge.

Transportation to and from the airport

Local transportation will be arranged by the organizers free of charge for national experts whose participation is covered by the project's budget. You will be met at the airport by a representative of the Council of Europe upon arrival.

Participants who will purchase their flight tickets are requested to send to the Secretariat in due time their arrival and departure dates and time, so that transportation can be arranged for them.

Observers are expected to arrange their own transportation to and from the Airport.

Travel, accommodation and catering

Conditions for coverage of travelling and subsistence expenses are specified in the invitation letters.

In principle, the following applies for national experts whose participation is covered by the project's budget.

=> *Travel*: Travelling expenses (plane, train or bus tickets, travel by car) of participants whose expenses are covered by the Council of Europe will be reimbursed to them, in accordance with the financial rules for 2004, by **bank transfer only** following the reception of the documentary evidence. Journeys should be arranged using the <u>most economical route</u>, making use, wherever possible, of any available reduced fares (Pex, excursion, etc.). Travel expenses will only be reimbursed upon presentation of documentary evidence of the sum actually paid (original invoice, copy of credit card slip, etc.). This evidence of the expenditure should be attached to the claim form for reimbursement together with a copy of the relevant travel tickets (plane, train, etc.). <u>Participants are advised to bring a copy of their entire travel ticket to the meeting to facilitate the reimbursement process.</u>

=> *Accommodation and catering* will be provided free of charge by the organisers. Accommodation will be arranged in:

Hotel Gracanica, Gracanica (at the end of the enclosing walls of the Gracanica's Monastery).

Observers are requested to make their own travel and hotel arrangements.
