At a municipal level

I have been elected to two municipalities in Greater London:

- 1982 Member of Hillingdon Council As leader of the Council I devolved power to area committees so that local voices could be heard.
- 2005 Member of Hackney Council I instigated a review into corruption in property sales and helped set up and manage a diverse community run market.

At a regional level

- I was elected to the London Assembly in 2008 where I have:
- Started review of rights of disabled people's access to health services.
- I produced recommendations to the Mayor of London for tackling overcrowding in housing.
- I am currently Chair of the London Assembly where my priority is to increase the participation of young people in the affairs of our city.
- I am a patron of the Believe Foundation, a charity supporting women who have been victims of domestic violence in London.

At a European level

- As a Congress member I have:
- Been involved with the development of the Council of Europe's policy on the rights of children to be heard.
- Member of the high-level delegation of solidarity with Ukraine in 2014.
- Rapporteur on LGBT+ issues producing two reports on Poland and the backsliding of rights in Europe.
- Rapporteur for the resilience of local and regional authorities.
- Human rights, Democracy and the Rule of Law.
