**50th Congress Session
 Strasbourg, plenary sittings 31 March-2 April 2026
 Draft abridged report – list of items discussed and decisions taken**

1. The oldest Congress representative present, Stewart DICKSON, opened the 50th Session. The list of participants appears in Appendix 1.
2. The Congress adopted Resolution 518 (2026) “Verification of new members’ credentials and official appointment procedures”, presented by the co-rapporteurs, Andrew BOFF, United Kingdom (R, ECR) and Martine DIESCHBURG-NICKELS, Luxembourg (L, ILDG).
3. The Congress elected its new President, Gunn Marit HELGESEN.
4. The Congress heard a statement by its newly elected President, Gunn Marit HELGESEN.
5. The Congress adopted the revised agenda as set out in Appendix 2. The Congress adopted the minutes of the last sitting of the 49th Session (30 October 2025) as set out in document CG(2025)49-PV-03. The Congress adopted the composition of Congress committees as set out in document CG(2026)50-03.
6. The Congress heard a statement by Marc COOLS, outgoing President of the Congress.
7. The Congress held a debate on the Russian Federation’s war of aggression against Ukraine and adopted Resolution 519 (2026) “A strategic approach to supporting the recovery and reconstruction of Ukraine at local and regional Levels”, as amended, presented by the co-rapporteurs, Véronique BERTHOLLE, France (L, SOC/G/PD) and Amelie TARSCHYS INGRE, Sweden (R, ILDG). The Congress heard statements by :

 - Oleksii KULEBA, Deputy Prime Minister for the Restoration of Ukraine – Minister for Development of Communities and Territories, Ukraine (on-line participation)
8. The Congress heard a statement by Bjørn BERGE, Deputy Secretary General of the Council of Europe and held an exchange of views with him.
9. The Congress held a debate and adopted Recommendation 543 (2026) and Resolution 521 (2026) “Free elections at the local and regional level”, presented by the rapporteur, Stewart DICKSON, United Kingdom (R, ILDG). The Congress heard a statement by Kevin CASAS-ZAMORA, Secretary General of the International Institute for Democracy and Electoral Assistance (International IDEA).
10. The Congress held a debate and adopted Recommendation 544 (2026) and Resolution 522 (2026) “Tackling violence against elected officials”, presented by the co-rapporteurs, Katrien PARTYKA, Belgium (R, PPE/CCE) and Bryony RUDKIN, United Kingdom (L, SOC/G/PD). The Congress heard a statement by Eider INUNCIAGA SERNA, Councillor for Basque Language, Public Services, Civic Engagement, Agenda 2030 and Internationalisation, Bilbao City Council, Spain.
11. The Congress adopted the minutes of the sitting of the Congress and of sessions of the chambers on 31 March 2026 as set out in documents CG(2026)50-PV-01, CPL(2026)50-PV and CPR(2026)50-PV-01.
12. The Congress took note of the results of the elections of the posts of vice-chairs of the committees, communicated by the President of the Congress.

13. The Congress adopted the texts approved by the Chamber of Local Authorities: Recommendation 540 (2026) “Monitoring of the application of the European Charter of Local Self-Government in Lithuania” and Recommendation 541 (2026) “Monitoring of the application of the European Charter of Local Self-Government in Monaco”, and the text approved by the Chamber of Regions: Recommendation 542 (2026) and Resolution 520 (2026) “Squeezed out? Bringing regional history teaching to the fore” as set out in document CG(2026)50-08.

14. The Congress heard a statement by Alexei BUZU, Secretary General of the Government of Republic of Moldova, on behalf of the Presidency of the Committee of Ministers, and heard his oral replies to written questions.

15. The Congress held a debate on “International disorder, regional consequences”. Introduced by Randi MONDORF, Denmark (R, ILDG).

16. The Congress held a debate and adopted Recommendation 545 (2026) as amended and Resolution 523 (2026) “Safeguarding local democracy in Georgia: Fact-finding report”, presented by the rapporteur, Stewart DICKSON, United Kingdom (R, ILDG).

17. The Congress held a debate and adopted Recommendation 546 (2026) and Resolution 524 (2026) “Strengthening the capacities of local and regional authorities in the use of artificial intelligence”, presented by the co-rapporteurs, Truls GIHLEMOEN, Norway (R, ECR) and Annika VAIKLA, Estonia (L, ILDG).

18. The Congress held a debate and adopted Recommendation 547 (2026) and Resolution 525 (2026) “Social rights at local and regional levels”, presented by the co-rapporteurs, Cecilia DALMAN EEK, Sweden (R, SOC/G/PD) and Martine DIESCHBURG-NICKELS, Luxembourg (L, ILDG).

19. The Congress adopted the minutes of the sitting of the Congress on 1 April 2026 as set out in document CG(2026)50-PV-02.

20. The Congress heard a statement by Mattias GUYOMAR, President of the European Court of Human Rights. It held a debate and adopted Recommendation 548 (2026) and Resolution 526 (2026) “Implementation of the European Convention on Human Rights by local and regional authorities: lessons from the case law of the European Court of Human Rights”, presented by the co-rapporteurs, Gudrun MOSLER-TÖRNSTRÖM, Austria (L, SOC/G/PD) and Mélanie LEPOULTIER, France (L, ILDG), as well as Resolution 527 (2026) “Human Rights Handbook – Freedom of expression and freedom of assembly and association”, presented by the co-rapporteur, Peter DRENTH, Netherlands (R, EPP/CCE).

21. The Congress held a debate on “From borders to boroughs: global movements, local responses” and heard statements by:

- Fatma ŞAHİN, Mayor of Gaziantep Metropolitan Municipality, Türkiye
- Elena CARLETTI, President of the Equal Rights and Opportunities Commission of the Region of Emilia Romagna, Italy

22. The Congress held a debate and adopted Recommendation 528 (2026) “Local elections in Estonia”, presented by the rapporteur, Jana FISCHEROVA, Czechia (L, ECR), Recommendation 529 (2026) “Local elections in North Macedonia”, presented by the rapporteur Gobnait NI MHUIMNEACAIN, Ireland (L, ILDG) and Recommendation 530 (2026) “Local elections in San Marino”, presented by the rapporteur Christa CARPELAN, Finland (L, EPP/CCE).
