Meeting of the Bureau of the Congress Strasbourg 6 December 2021 Abridged report – List of items discussed and decisions taken

- 1. The President of the Congress, Mr Leendert VERBEEK, opened the meeting. The list of participants appears in Appendix 1.
- 2. The Bureau adopted the agenda as set out in Appendix 2.
- 3. The Bureau took note of the communication by the President of the Congress.
- 4. The Bureau took note of the communication by the Secretary General of the Congress.
- 5. The Bureau took note of information on the meetings of the Bureau of the Chamber of Local Authorities and the Bureau of the Chamber of Regions held on 6 December 2021.
- 6. The Bureau took note of the information on the implementation of the 2021 budget and the budget for 2022-2023 and adopted a declaration on the Congress budget 2022-2023 as set out in Appendix 3.
- 7. The Bureau approved the changes in the composition of the national delegations as set out in Document CG-BUR(2021)42-44.
- 8. The Bureau took note of the timetable of meetings, as set out in Document CG(2021)42-01, and adopted the draft agenda of the 42nd Session of the Congress, as set out in Document CG(2021)42-OJ, and entrusted the President to make changes to the order of items as discussed. The Bureau also took note of the call for candidatures for youth delegates for 2022 as set out in Document CG-BUR(2021)42-INF73.
- 9. The Bureau took note of the list of Bureau rapporteurs and representatives in outside bodies, as set out in Document CG-BUR(2021)42-45, and agreed to resume the discussion at a future meeting.
- 10. The Bureau considered the situation concerning the Congress thematic spokespersons, appointed the following three thematic spokespersons:
- a. Thematic Spokesperson on the European Local Democracy Week: Bryony RUDKIN, United Kingdom, (L, SOC/G/PD)
- b. Thematic Spokesperson on Human Rights: Harald BERGMANN, Netherlands (L, ILDG)
- c. Thematic Spokesperson on Digitalisation and artificial intelligence: David ERAY Switzerland (R, EPP/CCE)

and decided that the other thematic spokespersons would be appointed at a later stage.

- 11. The Bureau took note of information on the Monitoring Committee activities and of the meetings of the Current Affairs Committee and of the Governance Committee held on 18 and 19 November 2021 respectively as set out in Documents CG/CUR(2021)19-DEC and CG/GOV(2021)19-DEC.
- 12. The Bureau took note of the calendar of local and regional elections as set out in Document CG-BUR(2021)42-INF76, and of the observation of local and regional elections held in Denmark on 16 November 2021 and the observation of the elections of the local self-government bodies held in Armenia 1-6 December 2021. The Bureau entrusted the three presidents with following up the feasibility of observing the municipal elections in the Netherlands on 16 March 2022 following receipt of an invitation.
- 13. With respect to Turkey, the Bureau reiterated its concern at the situation of opposition politicians in long term detention, notably that of Nurhayat ALTUN and Leyla GÜVEN, former members of the Turkish delegation to the Congress.

- 14. The Bureau took note of the discussions within the Committee of Ministers' Rapporteur Group on External Relations (GR-EXT) on the Council of Europe contribution to the UN Sustainable Development Goals, and on the Council of Europe policy toward neighbouring regions and relations with other organisations and the Congress' contribution thereto.
- 15. The Bureau took note of the Stocktaking of the Hungarian Presidency of the Committee of Ministers of the Council of Europe (21 May 17 November 2021) and of the Priorities of the Italian Presidency of the Committee of Ministers of the Council of Europe (17 November 2021 20 May 2022) as set out respectively in Documents CM/Inf(2021)20 and CM/Inf(2021)21.
- 16. The Bureau took note of the list of Congress meetings in 2021 and 2022 as set out in CG-BUR(2021)42-INF78.
- 17. The Bureau continued its follow-up to the brainstorming on the functioning and working methods of the Congress.

Appendix 3 – Bureau declaration on the Congress budget 2022-2023

CG-BUR(2021)42-46

The Bureau of the Congress of Local and Regional Authorities, in light of the Committee of Ministers Resolution CM/Res(2021)22 approving the Council of Europe <u>Programme</u> for 2022-2025 and the Budget for 2022, as well as the Budget for 2023 on a provisional basis:

- Welcomes the Committee of Minister's decision to adopt a budget for 2022 and 2023 taking into account inflation in line with the principle of Zero Real Growth;
- Thanks the heads of its national delegations for their support in light of Congress Recommendation 454 (2021) on the Budget of the Congress for 2022-2023;
- Regrets that the Congress' requests as set out in its Recommendation 454 (2021) on the Budget of the Congress for 2022-2023 have not been met;
- Further regrets that the Congress' call to concentrate activities of the Council of Europe for and with local and regional authorities under the Congress has not been met;
- 5. Welcomes the measures proposed by the Secretary General of the Council of Europe and approved by the Committee of Ministers in respect of monitoring bodies, including the Congress, to address the backlog caused by the delays due to Covid-19, including operational and staff resources:
- 6. Underlines, however, that these measures do not address the structural staff problems of the Congress which have led to delays in monitoring of the European Charter of Local Self-Government resulting in the fact that for more than one fifth of member States the monitoring cycle is longer than 5 years;
- Commits to continuing to improve its functioning and working methods and to identify resources outside the Council of Europe budget in order to allow the Congress to fulfil its mandate and achieve the expected <u>results</u>:
- Resolves to assess the possibilities proposed by national delegations and national authorities
 and to take decisions about activities to be continued or discontinued in view of the available ordinary
 and extrabudgetary resources:
- 9. Invites national delegations, national associations of local and regional authorities, and national authorities of member States to facilitate the Congress' return to a capacity to fulfil its mandate as set out in the Congress Charter by:
- seconding staff to the Congress secretariat and
- b. making voluntary contributions to finance concrete activities and projects such as the European Local Democracy Week, the Alliance of Cities and Regions for Roma Inclusion, the Pact of Towns and Regions against Sexual Exploitation of Children, the Summit of Mayors against Radicalisation or other activities, which are not fully funded:
- 10. Invites the Secretary General and the Committee of Ministers to make full use of the Congress' unique role in the institutional architecture of the Council of Europe and its potential to achieve the objective of improving democracy, human rights and the rule of law serving the women, men and children living in our 47 member States.
