Meeting of the Bureau of the Congress Strasbourg, France Monday 24 March and Thursday 27 March 2025

Abridged report - List of items discussed and decisions taken

Monday 24 March 2025

- 1. The President of the Congress, Mr Marc COOLS, opened the meeting. The list of participants is set out in Appendix 1.
- 2. The Bureau adopted the revised draft agenda as set out in Appendix 2.
- 3. The Bureau took note of the communication by the President of the Congress.
- 4. The Bureau took note of the communication by the Secretary General of the Congress.
- 5. The Bureau took note of the oral reports by the Chamber Presidents of the meetings of the Chamber Bureaux held on 24 March 2025.
- The Bureau took note of the information on the budget of the Congress.
- 7. The Bureau took note of the schedule of meetings during the session as set out in document CG(2025)48-01, and of the timetable and deadlines for elections to be held during the session, as set out in document CG-BUR(2025)63-17.

It adopted the revised draft agenda of the 48th Session of the Congress as set out in document CG(2025)48-OJ and approved the programme of chairing of the plenary sittings set out in document CG-BUR(2025)64-25.

It took note of the side events to be held during the session, as set out in document CG-BUR(2025)64-26.

It took note of the list of youth delegates for 2025, set out in document CG(2054)48-05, and of the good practice guide for national delegations in their contacts with youth delegates as set out in the document CG-BUR(2025)64-30.

- 8. The Bureau approved the changes in the composition of the national delegations as set out in document CG-BUR(2054)64-23 and adopted the draft resolution on the verification of new members' credentials, and new appointments procedures as set out in document CG-BUR(2025)64-24.
- 9. The Bureau pursued its discussions on the Russian Federation's war of aggression against Ukraine and took note of the recent developments.
- 10. The Bureau held an exchange of views on the situation of local and regional democracy in Türkiye and approved a draft declaration on dismissals of mayors in Türkiye, to be submitted to the plenary for adoption during the debate to be held under the urgent procedure on 27 March 2025.

- 11. The Bureau pursued its discussion on the situation in Georgia and took note of the recent developments. It also took note of the Draft Congress Recommendation and Resolution, as set out in document CG(2025)48-17, approved by the three Presidents following their high-level visit to Georgia carried out on 3-4 February 2025.
- 12. In the light of the information provided, the Bureau decided to set up an Ad hoc Working Group on follow-up to the Reykjavik Principles for Democracy under Chapter XI of the Congress Rules and Procedures and approved its composition as set out in Appendix 3.
- 13. The Bureau took note of the 2024 Activity Report of the Centre of Expertise for Multilevel Governance, as set out in document CG-BUR(2025)64-22.
- 14. The Bureau appointed Cecilia DALMAN EEK (Sweden, R, SOC/G/PD) as Bureau rapporteur for a democratic Belarus.
- 15. The Bureau held an exchange of views with the President of the GR-DEM, Ms Caitríona DOYLE, Ireland.
- 16. The Bureau held an exchange of views with the Standing Rapporteur on Human Rights, Gudrun MOSLER-TÖRNSTRÖM, (Austria, R, SOC/G/PD), on the work carried out during the first year since her appointment.
- 17. The Bureau took note of the information regarding local and regional elections.
- 18. The Bureau took note that no replies of the Committee of Ministers to Congress recommendations had been received since its previous meeting.

Thursday 27 March 2025

- 19. The Bureau approved the themes for the European Local Democracy Week (ELDW) for 2025-2026, as set in document CG-BUR(2025)64-21, and underlined a series of points to be taken into account in finalising proposals for reform of the ELDW, to be submitted to the Bureau at its next meeting.
- 19. The Bureau took note that no replies of the Committee of Ministers to Congress recommendations had been received since its previous meeting.
- 20. The Bureau took note of the activities of the committees.
- 21. The Bureau held a Session debriefing.
- 22. The Bureau accepted the invitation of Malta to meet in Malta on 12 June 2025. It took note of the sessions and Bureau meetings to be held in 2025, as set out in document CG-BUR(2025)64-28.
- 23. The Bureau adopted the present abridged report of the meeting as set out in document CG-BUR(2025)64-DEC.
