

Follow- up awareness raising activities of participants in the training course

Elya Sahakyan, teacher at the Mkhitar Sebastatsi educational center, posted a [video](#) where her students represent diverse women from various countries who identify themselves as feminists and fight for women's rights. The motto of the event was *"We are different, we are women, we are girls, and we have rights"*.

Anush Abazyan, teacher at No. 11 high school in Noyemberyan, organised an [open class](#) on the topic of "Discrimination against women" on 5 March 2021. Sixteen pupils from the 11th grade participated in the open class and had the opportunity to discuss the issues of gender inequality, historical overview of women's rights, and inequality between men and women.

Ararat Alikhanyan, program coordinator at Youth Cooperation Center in Dilijan, organised an online seminar-discussion on the topic of "Zero discrimination" on 7 March 2021, with 20 participants joining the [meeting](#). During the meeting, the concepts of hate speech, discrimination, UN reports, the Council of Europe manuals on human rights education were introduced.

Anna Kirakosyan, teacher at basic school in Karin and **Yelena Amiryan**, who works for the UNESCO "Education for Sustainable Development" platform, organised a [seminar-discussion](#) on the topic of "Discrimination against women" with about 25 pupils on 5 March 2021. During the seminar, the concepts of sex and gender, violence against women, inequality between men and women, types of discrimination were discussed.

Karine Avetisyan, teacher at the Vanashen secondary school, organised a [discussion](#) with the students on the topic of "Zero discrimination against women and girls" on 6 March 2021. The pupils had the chance to get familiar with the different types of discrimination.

Karine Qochoyan, teacher at the Gharibjanyan secondary school, organised an [open class](#) about the rights of women and girls and the types of discrimination they face for the pupils of 10th and 11th grades and a discussion with pupils of 12th grade on 3 and 5 March 2021.

Marianna Navasardyan, teacher at the no.42 high school in Yerevan, conducted a survey with the pupils of 12th grade. Teachers, parents of the pupils and other people participated in the survey (conducted on 2-4 March). During the [activity](#), the pupils got familiar with the concepts of hate speech, discrimination against women and girls, and were introduced to the prominent women in Armenian history.

Gasparyan, lawyer at the New Generation NGO organised an online meeting on the topic of “Women’s rights”. On 7 March 2021, an online awareness [event](#) was organised to raise awareness about the reasons and consequences of discrimination against women.

Syuzanna Hovsepyan, teacher at the Shoghakat secondary school, organised an offline seminar-discussion on the topic of “Women and men are different but equal: discrimination against women and girls” on 4 and 5 March 2021. In the first [video](#), a group of pupils discussed types of discrimination and its manifestations against women. In the second [video](#) the pupils discussed the concept of hate speech, expression of free speech and hate speech correlation, the pyramid of hate speech, and the links with human rights. Young people also discussed the roles and which types of discrimination women face in society and proposed joint solutions. The parents of the pupils also participated in the event, and through teamwork activities tried to be part of “solution makers”.
