However, all necessary material and technical support for the activities of the Committees (including the Secretariat) is provided by the Ministry of Health of the Republic of Azerbaijan.

Is free legal aid mechanism available (possibly under certain conditions)?

(X) YesAMADA has Pro Bono Policy which provides the athletes and other persons with free legal aid. Pro Bono legal aid entails free legal assistance by a legal professional offered to individuals charged with anti-doping rule violations during proceedings before Disciplinary and Appeal Committees. For this purpose, AMADA has signed memorandums of cooperation with two local legal firms

(BM Morisson Azerbaijan and SME Law). A person applying for legal aid should either dully fill in and submit an online application form posted on the website of AMADA or fill the form, download it as PDF and submit a printed version to the office if AMADA. Copies of other required documents, together with a completed application form, must be submitted to AMADA by e-mail, regular mail or in person. Once an application form is in line with the requirements set in the Policy, an applicant will receive the decision of a law firm within a reasonable time on whether their case is declined or admitted. The selection process of candidates from among those applying for Pro Bono legal assistance is exclusively at the discretion of a law firm undertaking provision of free legal assistance. AMADA can in no way influence the law firm' decision regarding selection and approval of applications.



If an athlete agrees with the sanction proposed by AMADA in the Notice of Charge (NoC) or fails to respond within the specified timeframe, AMADA will impose the sanction accordingly. Decisions issued by AMADA concerning Anti-Doping Rule Violations (ADRVs) may be appealed in accordance with Article 13 of the Azerbaijan Anti-Doping Rules.

If an athlete disagrees with the proposed sanction in the NoC, they have the right to request a hearing before the Disciplinary Committee (DC). The DC operates with full operational and institutional independence from AMADA. Decisions made by the DC may be appealed to the Appellate Committee (AC).

AC provides a formal avenue for the parties with right to appeal to challenge decisions made by the Disciplinary Committee (DC). Decisions of the AC may be challenged before CAS.
