In addition to this, all sports organizations have their own anti-doping programs in which they have defined how they take care about anti-doping education. Many NFs have defined that FINCIS's e-learning course is mandatory for certain target groups like for national teams, for major league level teams, staff etc. Education is mandatory also for Olympic and Paralympic teams and those who receive funding from the Ministry of Education and Culture. Also sport institutes and sport academies plan annually how their target groups get anti-doping education.
