- (1) The appeal doping procedure to be launched as a result of appealing the hearing panel's decision adopted in the first instance, or cases set out in WADA Code, relevant international standards, and other grounds specified in HUNADO Rules, shall be conducted by doping appeal committee except for cases provided for in Section (2). The appeal doping committee shall operate within the organizational framework of the Permanent Court of Arbitration for Sport.
- (2) In cases arising from participation in an International Event or in cases involving International-Level Athletes the decision may be appealed exclusively to Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS).
