INVITATION LETTER

Dear Mr/Ms,

It is a pleasure to invite you to participate on the panel discussion "Patterns and degree of discrimination in Montenegro – 2020" that Center for Democracy and Human Rights – CEDEM, in cooperation with the Council of Europe, will hold on Friday, 27th of November, in ZOOM platform.

In order to support the national institutions in combating discrimination and ensuring a more inclusive society in this emergency, the Council of Europe, in consultation with the Ministry of Human and Minority Rights and with the Ombudsperson's Office, decided to launch a country-wide survey on discrimination patterns, against vulnerable groups as per the ECRI 2017 report on Montenegro and issues identified therewith. The survey is among the activities implemented in the framework of the action on 'Promotion of diversity and equality in Montenegro', part of the EU-COE programmatic framework Horizontal Facility for the Western Balkans and Turkey.

In this regard, CEDEM conducted the research from 11th to 19th September 2020 and the results and recommendations will be presented, accompanied with a panel discussion on key findings with representatives of CSOs dealing with vulnerable groups. The draft agenda of the event is enclosed below.

In addition, the survey aimed at identifying whether discrimination against vulnerable groups has changed due to the COVID outbreak. The survey provides information on individuals' perceptions and direct experiences of human rights violations as well as their knowledge and assessment of the work of human rights institutions in Montenegro. It also generates data, which will serve the Ombudsperson's Office to identify which human rights related issues are of concern to persons living in Montenegro, so it could develop appropriate counter measures.
