

The Media and Information Agency (MIA) serves as an information hub answering the needs of the public, the media, and the government. MIA fulfils two key functions: it supplies information to the public on the work being done by the government and it supplies information to the government so that it can be properly informed and do the work well. The agency informs the media and the public of measures taken, laws passed, as well as policies formulated by the government. The Agency provides the media with enhanced transparency, while it does not change or affect the relation between spokespersons of the ministries and reporters/journalists. Similar agencies exist in different EU member states.
