





The Russian Ka-52 helicopter downed near Gostomel was probably flown by the squadron commander of the 319th Separate Helicopter Regiment from the Primorsky Krai of the Russian Federation, Airat Safargaleyev.







24 February 2022, the day of Russian invasion

In 14 hours after the war started we have published our first investigative story. We found out who was the pilot of Russian helicopter which was downed next to Kyiv

How we investigate war crimes

- 1) Find the crime and victims
- Go into field for reporting, talk to people, collect proofs
- Figuring out what Russian unit was based in the location
- Identifying Russian soldiers, printing their pictures
- 5) Showing pictures to victims and witnesses
- Collecting more proofs about persons who commit the crime
- 7) Call/text Russian militaries with questions
- 8) Publish the story





After publishing a story

- Prosecutors or other official investigators collect information from our stories and use in their criminal cases
- Officials asked us to train their employees how to identify people
- All identified Russian soldiers we put into the special database we released in May - "Russian War Criminals." We also put there the soldiers identified by other Ukrainian outlets

One of the key objectives of the project is to assist in gathering evidence of crimes committed by individuals during hostilities - for further use by Ukrainian and international investigators and to provide this evidence in Ukrainian courts and the International Criminal Court (The Hague, The Netherlands).

The Ukrainian prosecutor's office has declared suspicion of violating the rules and customs of war to Major Alexander Vasiliev - he and another Russian serviceman tortured two residents of Bohdaniyka: a prisoner of war and a local priest, Father Anthony. The latter said that the Russians beat him and forced him to undress in public.
