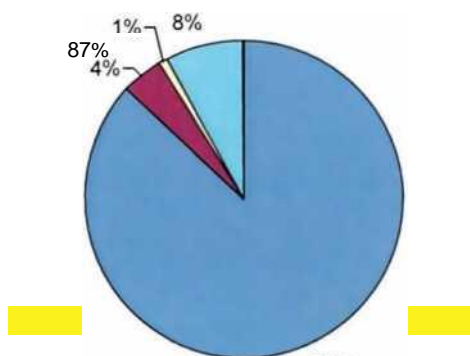


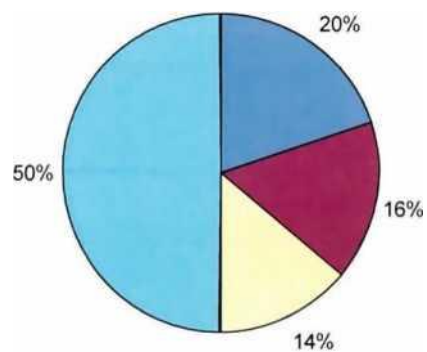
Placement of the national/ethnic minorities and community using regional language
