1. pursue the efforts to establish a national park including both reserves as well as surrounding islands and waters;

The process of establishing the area as a national park is expected to start during the next year.

2. continue to monitor the activities which are potential sources of disturbances, and enforce the regulations regarding in particular the access to closed areas and make the monitoring results easily accessible to managers and visitors;

The bird sanctuaries have been regarded during the period in question. The proliferation of toxic algae in the archipelago is being assessed on a regular basis. The monitoring results of toxic algae have been easily accessible to visitors.

3. continue providing support to farming activities on the islands, following the objectives of landscape and biodiversity conservation;

The grazing and haymaking has continued. As this summer was very dry and many farmers had problems in getting enough cattlefood, the hay was transported to land to be used.

4. continue the campaign to control the population of minks.

During the year the number of traps in use have been increased to 70. 24 minks have been trapped. Despite the efforts the population of minks continues to increase.

A new person has been recruited to work with the management of propertys owned by the Swedish Environmental Protection Agency. A pilot study is going on about implementing a new sewage system on Bullerön.
