





Aeroplane

- Strasbourg Airport (SXB)
- EuroAirport Basel-Mulhouse-Freiburg (BSL): then take a shuttle bus to St Louis train station & a TER train to Strasbourg
- Frankfurt Airport (FRA): then take the Lufthansa Express Bus or a train to Strasbourg

Train

- <u>Eurostar</u> to Paris, then TGV train to Strasbourg
- TGV via the website of the <u>SNCF</u>
