

AVMSD TRANSPOSITION HIGHLIGHTS - FINLAND



Finland has transposed the AVMSD 2018/1808 with the Law amending the Act on Electronic Communications Services that entered into force on 01 January 2021:

Protection of minors (Article 6a of the AVMSD)

- The notion of harm also includes violent, sexual, or anxiety-inducing content
- A visible sign to be displayed for 7, 12, 16, and 18 on or in connection with the programme
- Possibility for an exception for minors 3 years younger than the minimum age limit if accompanied by an adult



Accessibility (Article 7 of the AVMSD)

- Accessibility measures include subtitles, signing, descriptions, audio service and spoken subtitles
- No audio and subtitling for live music performances or sports events
- Non-public broadcasters' costs in providing audio and subtitling service: max. 1% of revenue
- No mention of accessible emergency information for people with disabilities



European works (Articles 13, 16, 17 of the AVMSD)

- 30% quota obligation for European works in VOD catalogues
- General prominence obligation
- No financial contribution obligations imposed on VOD service providers
- The majority of free-to-air annual transmission time obligations of European works for both commercial and public service broadcasters
- 19% transmission time for independent works or 10% minimum programming budget



Advertising (Article 23 of the AVMSD)

 Television advertising spots and teleshopping spots: 06.00-18.00 and 18.00-24.00: max. 20% of that period



Video-sharing platforms (Article 28b of the AVMSD)

- VSP providers must prohibit harmful content uploading in their terms and conditions
- The law applies if a Finnish citizen or permanent resident provides the programme or if the decision is made in Finland



Media literacy (Article 33a of the AVMSD)

 General obligation to promote media literacy with strong emphasis on a child-safe media environment
