

AVMSD TRANSPOSITION HIGHLIGHTS - LITHUANIA



Lithuania has transposed the AVMSD 2018/1808 with various legislative amendments that entered into force at the end of 2020.

Protection of minors (Article 6a of the AVMSD)



- Must be marked with 'N-7' if it has negative impact on < 7
- 21.00 06.00: "N-14" to be displayed if it has a negative impact on < 14
- 23.00 06.00: index 'S' to be displayed if it has a detrimental effect on minors
- Audible warnings, pictorial signs to be displayed
- Public computer network providers must ensure the use of harmful content filtering tools

Accessibility (Article 7 of the AVMSD)



- On a monthly transmission time basis, the public service broadcaster must adapt TV programmes for people with hearing and visual impairments:
 - o min. 50% for Lithuanian subtitled programmes
 - o min. 20% for Lithuanian sign language programmes
 - o min. 10% for programmes for visually impaired

European works (Articles 13, 16, 17 of the AVMSD)



- 30% quota obligation for European works in VOD catalogues >1% total revenue and audience
- No financial contribution obligations imposed on VOD service providers
- 50% transmission time obligation for both commercial and public service broadcasters
- 10% transmission time for independent works ~ for recent works (< 5years)



Advertising (Article 23 of the AVMSD)

• Television advertising spots and teleshopping spots: 06.00-18.00 and 18.00-24.00: max. 20% of that period



Video-sharing platforms (Article 28b of the AVMSD)

• VSPs must change their measures if the Board determines that they are inappropriate or applicable standards of conduct are ineffective.



Media literacy (Article 33a of the AVMSD)

• To enhance media literacy education, the government will appoint an institution that will evaluate the measures and report to the EU Commission
