Yuriy Gurzhy was born in Kharkiv, Ukraine and now lives in Berlin. He is a musician, DJ, producer and radio broadcaster as well as a successful writer. He has been an author and the leading force in a number of musical acts, most notably RotFront, the Shtetl Superstars, Kaminer and die Antikorpsers, the Disorienalists and many others. In Ukraine he has collaborated with Zhadan on several musical projects, involving Ukrainian poetry of Vidrodzhennia period. Yuriy has been involved in a number of humanitarian projects supporting Ukraine now and since 2014, including for children in the Donetsk (Popasna).

Katya Tasheva, originally from Varna in Bulgaria and now living in Berlin, has been the main vocalist of two Berlin bands: "Rotfront", experiencing European-wide with its success combination of Eastern European music, rock, ska, reggae and hip hop, and "Mr. Zarko", a band with a talented international crew that gives a theatricalimprovisational touch to Balkan music. Since January 2016 she supports the team of the youth organization for Roma and non-Roma, Amaro Foro, with music courses for children.



Sergiy Fomenko aka Foma, originally from Kyiv, Ukraine, a long-standing frontman and a leader of the Mandry band, a wellknown Ukrainian ethno rock musician, producer and most recently documentary films director. Foma is actively involved in organisation and provision of humanitarian aid to Ukraine through a variety of support provided to various Ukrainian and international initiatives.



DJ Derbastler (Ivan Moskalenko), from Kyiv, Ukraine, is one of the most known Ukrainian electronic musicians. The partriarche of the Ukrainian rave and electronic music movement. A longstanding collaborator of Gogol Bordello (their regular tour DJ), Mama Diaspora and numerous other musical projects. Most recently the founder of the Artdopomoga art and music project, a collaboration platform, supporting humanitarian aid to Ukraine.
