

Q1. Local legislation requires to include VAT in all financial offers, except in the cases where the client can provide a Tax-exemption letter. Will such a letter be provided by the Council of Europe?

If yes, should the bidder, when calculating the financial offer, insert the VAT as 0%?

A1. Council of Europe Office in Pristina is VAT exempt. The Council of Europe will provide the selected tenderer with Tax-exemption letter upon receiving the final invoice. A quote describing the financial offer should be VAT exclusive.
