MAIN OBJECTIVES

- To support a more **coherent application of judicial practice** in view to ensure legal certainty
- To enhance the efficiency of the judiciary and its capacity to protect and promote human rights

EXPECTED OUTPUTS AND RESULTS

- 1. The case law database and case management systems used by the courts in Bosnia and Herzegovina apply the same case classification methodology and use vocabulary and descriptors compatible with the European Court of Human Rights in human rights cases;
- 2. Strengthened case law departments;
- 3. Improved efficiency of courts and ensured better judicial protection for citizens in line with the judgments of the European Court of Human Rights;
- 4. Strengthened capacity of National Training Institutions for judges and prosecutors; 5. Support of law faculties to provide human rights training.

KEY ACTIVITIES

- Development of a methodology of human rights case classification;
- Organisation of training sessions and study visits for legal professionals on ECHR issues;
- Revival of harmonisation panels **in order to** increase the consistency of jurisprudence across the country ensuring uniform interpretation of the law;
- Development of a report and organisation of **workshops and conferences on the length of proceedings** and the European practice addressing this issue;
- Creation of legal clinics within law faculties and implementation of training sessions addressed to students;
