She coordinates the Commission for Monitoring the Implementation of the National Gender Equality Strategy 2025–2029. At the international level, she is a member of the Gender Equality Commission of the Council of Europe and the Regional Coordination Committee for the Balkan Region. She is also a certified trainer in the field of anti-discrimination and gender equality.
