Mr Thomas Ahlstrand is a Swedish national. He is the vice president of the Swedish NGO-umbrella "The Platform against human trafficking", organising 26 NGO:s working against trafficking, among these the Salvation Army, Ecpat, Caritas, Talita and others.

Up to September 2023 he was the Deputy Chief Prosecutor at the National Public Prosecution Department in Gothenburg where he worked as a prosecutor in cases against trafficking and organised crime, mainly with international elements. He has since occasionally worked as a judge in the Court of Appeals and as a prosecutor.

Trained as a lawyer with a Master of Law degree from the University of Lund he has been a public prosecutor for about 30 years. For the last 15 years, he has been specialising in cases concerning trafficking in human beings for sexual as well as other purposes. He has taught and lectured on the subject in different international and national conferences. He has also published a number of opinion editorials, many on the subject of trafficking in human beings, in major Swedish journals.
