Ms Ulrike Haberl-Schwarz is an Austrian national. She holds a PhD in law from the University of Graz supplemented by a LL.M. from the Vienna University of Economics and Business.

Currently she is a member and chair of the Selection Panel for the establishment of the European Public Prosecutor's Office.

The last 15 years of her professional career she held the position of the appointed President of the Court of First Instance in Leoben, Austria. From 2003 to 2007 she was the Austrian National Member and Vice President of the European Union Agency for Criminal Justice Cooperation (Eurojust).

She started her carreer at the Court of First Instance in Salzburg as an investigating judge in 1990, followed by functions as a judge in labour and social law and civil and commercial matters.
