

Mr Aurelijus Gutauskas is a Lithuanian national. He studied law at the Police Academy of Law in Vilnius (Mykolas Romeris University). He holds a PhD in criminal law from Mykolas Romeris University ("Organised Crime and its Criminal Legal Evaluation"). From 2013 to March 2023, he worked as a judge in the Criminal Division of the Supreme Court of Lithuania, and since 2018, he has been the Chairman of the Criminal Division of the Supreme Court of Lithuania. His responsibilities as a judge include dealing with criminal cases related with organised crime, trafficking in human beings and illegal migration. In March 2023, he was appointed as a judge in the Constitutional Court of Lithuania.

Mr Gutauskas is a professor in the Criminal Justice Department at the Faculty of Law at Vilnius University. He has almost 25 years of experience in teaching various courses on criminal law in Lithuanian and English. He has published over 60 scientific articles, textbooks and monographs in Lithuanian and other languages on relevant topics of criminal justice.

He is member of the Public Council of International Experts in Ukraine for the fight against corruption (since 2018), expert to the Select Committee of Experts on the Evaluation of Anti-Money Laundering Measures (MONEYVAL) (since 2006), and expert to the Group of States against corruption (GRECO) (since 2007).
