- Learning more on the conceptual and pragmatical issues related to SOGIESC;
- Learning more on the evolution of the laws regarding SOGIESC: the legal forces and tools pushing for changes and the one resisting;
- Learning more on the diversity of legal approaches and the importance of the cultural context, through the comparative studies of international and internal laws.

The part of their work related to the context of the case, will be presented online, one or two weeks before the in-presence meeting, whereas the commentary itself of the case will be presented on the 14th of May, for the morning session.
