Brief introduction

Social media and the question of democratic participation is not just a goal or a task, but a widely discussed approach full of experience, fear, hope and fast changes. In the face of challenges such as these, it has become clear that new kinds of citizens are required: citizens that are not only informed and understand their formal responsibilities as citizens, but also active – able to freely contribute to the life of their community, their country and the wider world, and actively participate in ways that express their individuality and help to solve problems by not just trying to influence leaders, but by communicating through face to face communication or social media with each other.

This obviously starts with the participation of young people and is particularly relevant because in many societies a declining engagement of young people with traditional political processes can be seen also and especially in western democracies. How to train teacher trainers, teachers, students? How to make them aware of the potential of social media for democratic participation?

In Module B we want to share the proposals of the participants and learn about their test trainings. How can a proposal be adapted so it can be published and is understandable for other trainers and education professionals in the Pestalozzi network?

Expected outcomes

- To share, discuss and improve the piloted Training Units
- To further explore democratic participation in relation to the use of social media
- To become aware of the guidelines and key criteria for the editing of the TU's on the Pestalozzi platform
- To set up a network of education professionals and shape the specific contribution of SOCMED to the existing community of practice

Target group

Participants have developed their training units and have piloted them between Module A and Module B. During Module B they are ready to revise those training units and start their final editing for their dissemination. Together with the dissemination at local, regional or national level participants will continue working with other participants on-line, as a self sustaining network after the the module series.
