To the Members of the Bureau of the Assembly

Synopsis

of the meeting held in Paris on 3 September 2026

The Bureau of the Assembly, meeting on Thursday, 3 September 2026, in Paris, with Ms Petra Bayr, President of the Parliamentary Assembly, in the Chair, as regards:

- **Communications:**
 - took note of the communication by the President of the Parliamentary Assembly;
 - held an exchange of views with the Deputy Secretary General of the Council of Europe;
- **Fourth part-session of 2026 (Strasbourg, 28 September – 2 October):** drew up the draft agenda;
- **References and transmissions to committees:** approved the references and transmissions as set out in Appendix 1, subject to ratification by the Assembly through the Progress report;
- **Election observation:**
 - Assembly of Kosovo*: early elections (7 June 2026): approved the report of the observation mission;
 - Kazakhstan: early parliamentary elections (23 August 2026): took note of the statement of the observation mission;
 - Morocco: parliamentary elections (23 September 2026): took note of the statement of the pre-electoral observation mission, approved the revised list of members of the *ad hoc* committee to observe these elections and appointed Ms Sevilay Çelenk (Türkiye, UEL) as Vice-chairperson of the delegation for the main mission (Appendix 2);
 - Bosnia and Herzegovina: general elections (4 October 2026): approved the revised list of members of the *ad hoc* committee to observe these elections, concluded that the conditions for meaningful observation of out-of-country voting were not met, and decided to postpone the out-of-country voting pilot project to another election (Appendix 3);
 - Bulgaria: presidential election (25 October 2026): took note of the invitation to observe this election and decided not to follow up on it;
 - Serbia: parliamentary elections (October 2026, date tbc): subject to receiving an invitation, decided to observe these elections and to set up an *ad hoc* committee composed of 20 members (SOC-7; EPP/CD-5; ECPA-4; ALDE-3; UEL-1), as well as the two co-rapporteurs of the Committee on the Honouring of Obligations and Commitments by Member States of the Council of Europe (Monitoring Committee), and to organise a pre-electoral mission;
 - Palestine: parliamentary elections (28 November 2026): took note of the new date and the updated information regarding the security situation;

* All reference to Kosovo, whether to the territory, institutions or population shall be understood in full compliance with United Nations Security Council Resolution 1244 and without prejudice to the status of Kosovo.

- Kirghizstan: presidential election (27 January 2027): subject to receiving an invitation, decided to observe this election and to set up an *ad hoc* committee composed of 11 members (SOC-3; EPP/CD-3; ECPA-2; ALDE-2; UEL-1);
- Annual Meeting of Endorsers of the Declaration of Principles for International Election Observation (La Antigua, Guatemala, 2-4 December 2026): appointed Mr Antonio Gutiérrez Limones (Spain, SOC) as the Assembly's representative to participate in this meeting;
- Parliamentary Alliance for Free and Fair Elections: approved the revised list of members of this Alliance (Appendix 4).
- **Meetings of the Standing Committee and the Bureau in 2027:** approved the proposals contained in the memorandum prepared by the Secretariat (Appendix 5);
- **Václav Havel Human Rights Prize:** took note of the shortlist made by the Selection Panel at its meeting in Prague on 1 September 2026, consisting of (in alphabetical order): Ms Masih Alinejad (Iran-America), Ms Márta Pardavi (Hungary) and Ms Nasrin Sotoudeh (Iran);
- **Meetings elsewhere than Strasbourg and Paris:**
 - authorised the Parliamentary Network on the situation of the children of Ukraine (Committee on Social Affairs, Health and Sustainable Development) to meet in Vienna on 3 November 2026 (financed by voluntary contributions);
- **Date and place of next meetings:** decided to hold its next meetings as follows:
 - Monday 28 September 2026, 8.00 am, Strasbourg (part session);
 - Friday 2 October 2026, 8.30 am, Strasbourg (part-session);
