Revised Synopsis

of the meeting held in Strasbourg on 30 January 2026

The Bureau of the Assembly, meeting on Friday, 30 January 2026, in Strasbourg, with Ms Petra Bayr, President of the Parliamentary Assembly, in the Chair, as regards:

- **Follow-up to the first part-session of 2026 (Strasbourg, 26-30 January):** approved the follow-up proposals, as set out in Appendix 1.
- **References and transmissions to committees:** approved the references as set out in Appendix 2, subject to ratification by the Assembly through the Progress report.
- **Election observation:**
 - *Hungary: Parliamentary elections (12 April 2026):* approved the list of members of the *ad hoc* committee to observe the elections and appointed Pablo Hispan (Spain, EPP/CD) as its Chairperson and Ms Elisabetta Gardini (Italy, ECPA) as its Vice-Chairperson (Appendix 3);
 - *Joint hearing co-organised by the Parliamentary Assembly, the Congress of Local and Regional authorities and the Venice Commission on “Securing the rights of observers for trust and inclusive electoral processes (Paris, 28-29 April 2026), as a contribution to the New Democratic Pact”:* approved the list of members of the *ad hoc* committee (Appendix 4);
 - *Armenia: Parliamentary elections (June 2026 – date tbc):* decided, subject to receiving an invitation, to observe these elections and to set up an *ad hoc* committee composed of 20 members (SOC-7; EPP/CD-5; ECPA-4; ALDE-3; UEL-1), as well as the two co-rapporteurs of the monitoring committee, and to conduct a pre-electoral mission;
 - *Parliamentary Network for free and fair elections:* approved the updated list of members of the Parliamentary Alliance for Free and Fair Elections (Appendix 5).
- **OECD Global Parliamentary Network (Paris, 11-13 March 2026):** following its decision of 26 January, taken by written consultation, to set up an *ad hoc* committee to participate in this meeting, approved the list of members of the *ad hoc* committee and appointed its chairperson (Appendix 6).
- **High-level conference on the European Social Charter (Chişinău, 18-19 March 2026):** following its decision of 26 January, taken by written consultation, to set up an *ad hoc* committee to participate in this conference, approved the list of members of the *ad hoc* committee (Appendix 7).
- **Black Sea Security Forum, Odesa, Ukraine, 29-31 May 2026:** decided to set up an *ad hoc* committee of the Bureau to participate in this event, subject to security conditions.
- **Composition of committees:**
 - *Committee on the Honouring of Obligations and Commitments by Member States of the Council of Europe (Monitoring Committee):*
 - on the basis of a proposal by the UEL Group, nominated Mr Dionysios-Charalampos KALAMATIANOS (Greece) as member.

- **Institutional representation of the Parliamentary Assembly in 2026:** approved the proposals as set out in Appendix 8.
- **European Committee for the Prevention of Torture and Inhuman or Degrading Treatment or Punishment (CPT) - List of candidates in respect of Hungary:** approved the list of candidates in respect of this country to be forwarded to the Committee of Ministers.
- **Meetings elsewhere than Strasbourg and Paris:** authorised:
 - the Committee on Legal Affairs and Human Rights to meet in Tallinn on 26-27 May or June 2026;
 - the Committee on the Honouring of Obligations and Commitments by Member States of the Council of Europe (Monitoring Committee) to meet in Sarajevo on 28-29 May 2026;
 - the Committee on Culture, Science, Education and Media to meet in Istanbul on 2-3 June 2026.
- **Date and place of next meetings:** decided to hold its next meetings as follows:
 - Monday 2 March 2026, 11am, Paris;
 - Monday 20 April 2026, 8 h, Strasbourg (part-session);
 - Friday 24 April 2026, 8 h 30, Strasbourg (part session).
