The Bureau is invited to take note of the implementation of the Work Programme (Appendix 1 to this document) of the European Landscape Convention (www.coe.int/en/web/landscape), and in particular to:

1. Reference texts of the Committee of Ministers

- take note that on 16 October 2019, at their 1357th meeting, the Ministers' Deputies adopted the following recommendations:
 - Recommendation <u>CM/Rec(2019)7</u> of the Committee of Ministers to member States with a view to the implementation of the European Landscape Convention of the Council of Europe Landscape integration in policies relating to rural territories in agricultural and forestry, energy and demographic transition;
 - Recommendation $\underline{\mathsf{CM}/\mathsf{Rec}(2019)8}$ of the Committee of Ministers to member States with a view to the implementation of the European Landscape Convention of the Council of Europe Landscape and democracy: public participation.

2. Parties to the Convention

- invite member States that have not yet done so to consider signing and/or ratifying the <u>European Landscape Convention</u>. At 30 October 2019, 39 States have ratified the Convention: Andorra, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belgium, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Georgia, Greece, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Republic of Moldova, Montenegro, Netherlands, North Macedonia, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, San Marino, Serbia, Slovak Republic, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Turkey, Ukraine and the United Kingdom; two States have signed it: Iceland and Malta; www.coe.int/en/web/conventions/full-list/-/conventions/treaty/176
- invite member States that have not yet done so to consider ratifying the <u>Protocol amending the European Landscape Convention</u>; take note that two other States have deposited the instrument of ratification of the Protocol with the Treaty Office of the Council of Europe: Hungary (11 December 2018) and Slovenia (6 March 2019). www.coe.int/en/web/conventions/full-list/-/conventions/treaty/219

3. National landscape policies: Information System

- invite the representatives of the States Parties to the Convention, if they so wish, to translate the Glossary of the Information System of the European Landscape Convention (Council of Europe publication, Spatial Planning and Landscape Series, 2018, No. 106) and thanks and congratulates the Historical Heritage Institute of the Ministry of Culture and Sport of Spain for having recently translated it into Spanish.

4. Council of Europe Conference on the implementation of the Convention

The main objectives of the Work Programme are to promote participatory democracy, maintaining and deepening dialogue and co-operation between public authorities and civil society for the implementation of the European Landscape Convention by:

- Organising the biennial Council of Europe Conferences on the European Landscape Convention, according to the terms of reference of Committees of Experts set up under Article 17 of the Statute of the Council of Europe designated by the Committee of Ministers of the Council of Europe to be responsible for monitoring the implementation of the Convention (Article 10 of the Convention – Monitoring of the implementation of the Convention);
- 2. Organising annually one or several Council of Europe Meetings of the Workshops for the implementation of the European Landscape Convention;
- 3. Maintaining the Information System of the Council of Europe European Landscape Convention, and launching its Third Phase of activity, with the preparation of national and regional reports and thematic reports on public policies of Parties to the Convention (according to Recommendation CM/Rec(2013)4 on the European Landscape Convention Information System of the Council of Europe and its glossary, adopted by the Committee of Ministers on 11 December 2013);
- 4. Continuing the organisation of the Sessions of the Council of Europe's Landscape Award in the framework of the Council of Europe Landscape Alliance Award and of the Forums on the national selections of the Landscape Award (according to the Resolution CM/Res(2008)3 on the rules governing the Landscape Award of the Council of Europe and to the Resolution CM/Res(2017)18 on the Landscape Award Alliance of the Council of Europe, adopted by the Committee of Ministers on 27 September 2017);
- 5. Continuing the preparation of thematic reports and draft recommendations of the Committee of Ministers on natural, rural, urban and peri-urban areas, considered as outstanding, of everyday life and degraded, inland and maritime waters being taken into consideration;
