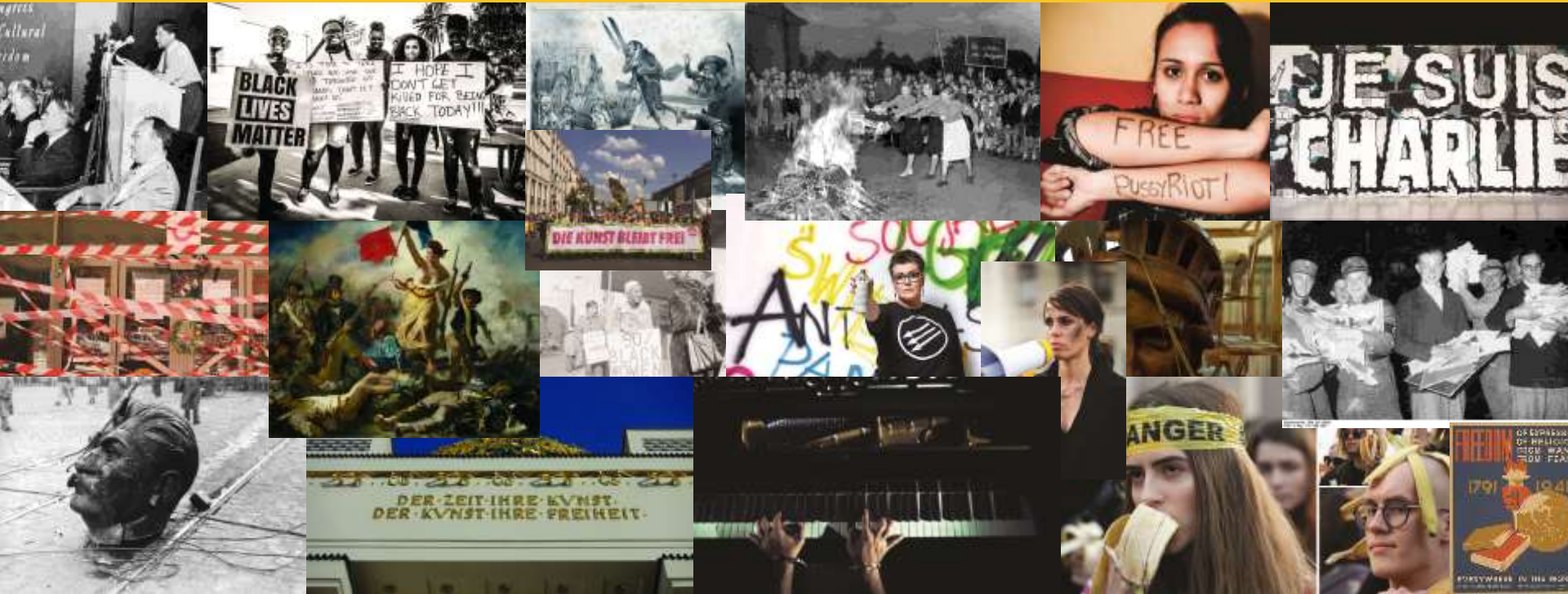

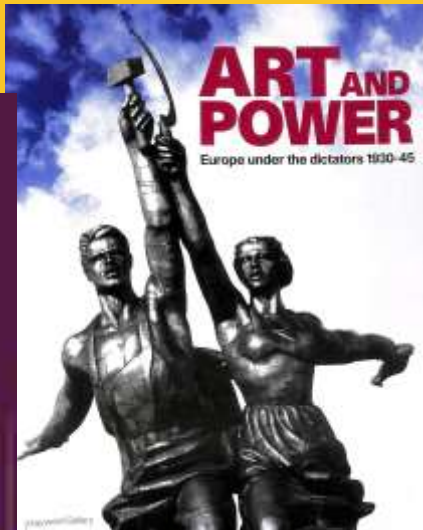

Manifesto on Freedom of Expression of Arts and Culture in Digital Era

The Council of Europe is the oldest and only pan-European body ensuring Human Rights, Democracy and the Rule of Law for 830 million citizens in Europe. It does so by means of the 1950 European Convention on Human Rights and the European Court of Human Rights that was established in 1960. Over the years, a multitude of legal monitoring, capacity building and awareness-raising instruments has been added to the arsenal in the policy section relevant for ensuring the respect for and implementation of

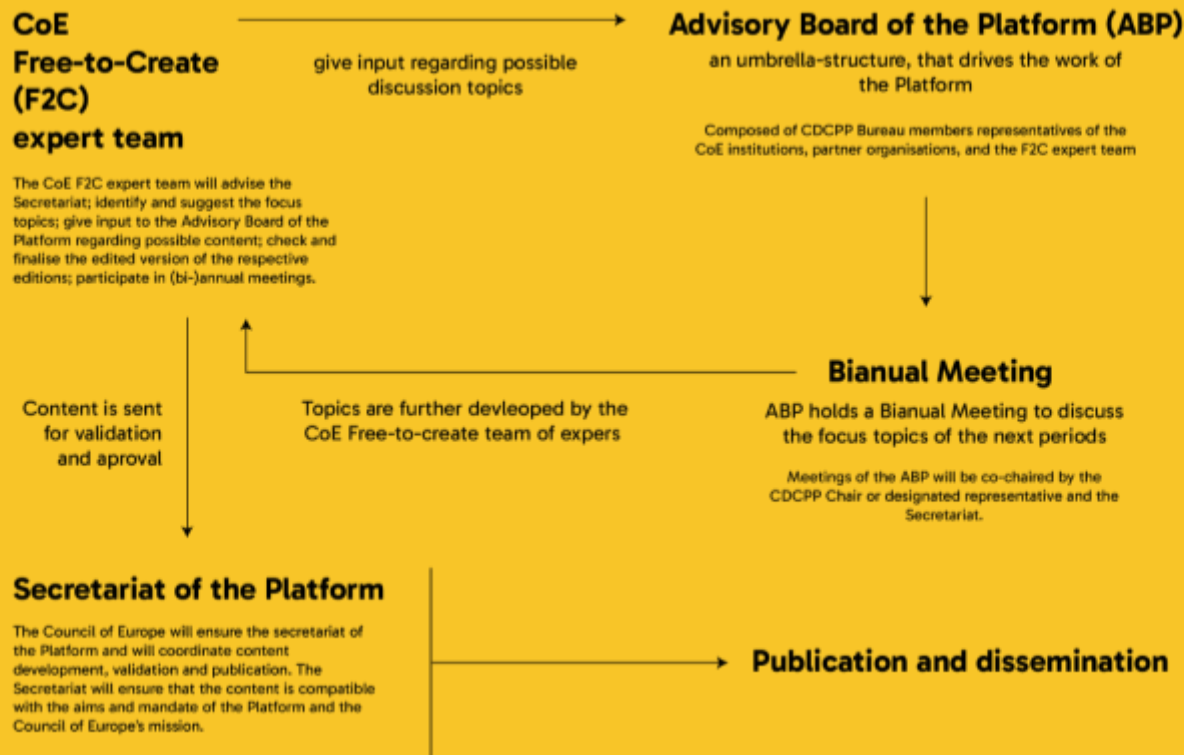

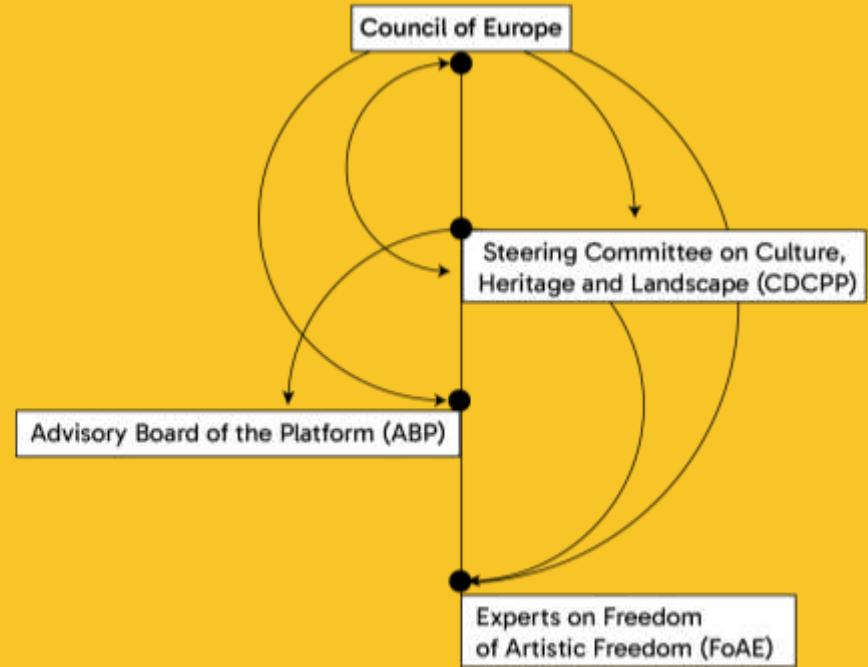


Governance
